Singapore, October 21, 1993 - Compaq Computer Corporation (NYSE: CPQ) today reported that third quarter net income more than doubled to \$107 million compared to \$49 million in the same period in 1992. Earnings per share increased 105 percent to \$1.25 versus \$.61 per share in the third quarter of 1992.

Compaq reported record sales for the fifth consecutive quarter. Third quarter sales were \$1.75 billion, a 64 percent increase over the \$1.07 billion in the third quarter of 1992.

The Company said that all geographic regions contributed to the year-to-year sales growth. Europe and North America grew at 37 and 75 percent respectively, and Japan, Latin America and the Pacific Rim regions all grew at rates in excess of 100 percent. Compaq noted that worldwide sales growth of 64 percent was accompanied by a 70 percent growth in worldwide unit volumes.

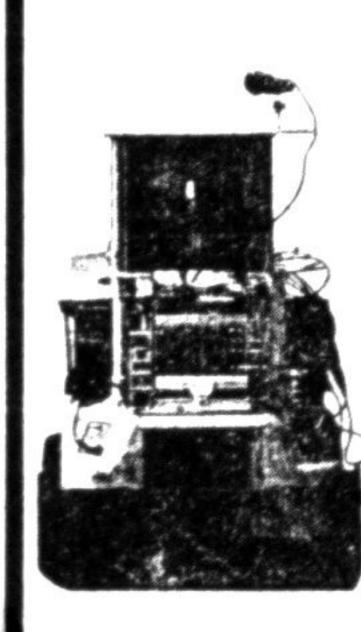
Computer Exhibition & Seminar at Chittagong

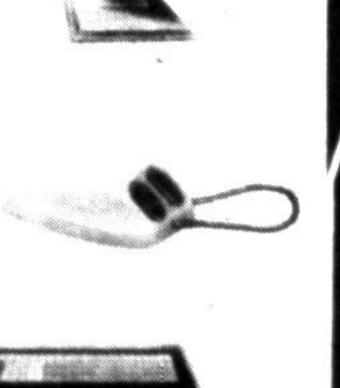
