the treasury to obtain release of fresh funds in time. He also urged the Board authorities to accelerate the pace of land acquisition and collection of water rates.



The House was also told. during the question-answer hour, that Tk 18 is spent for food for each patient at the country's all hospital including the PG hospital.

However, Tk 22 and Tk 25 are spent for every patient at the paying bed and cabin respectively.
