

CEPZ plans to embark on 3rd phase expansion programme

CHITTAGONG, Nov 23: The authorities wooing more foreign investments plan to embark on the third phase expansion programme at the country's first operational export processing zone based in Chittagong.

Mexican Senate approves NAFTA

MEXICO CITY, Nov 23: Mexican lawmakers gave final approval Monday to the North American Free Trade Agreement despite last-minute pleas from opposition leaders to reject the pact as unfair, reports AP.

The governing Institutional Revolutionary Party, or PRI, controls 61 of the 64 Senate seats, though eight PRI Senators were absent for Monday's vote. Under Mexican law, a vote of the lower House of Deputies was not required to approve the treaty legislation.

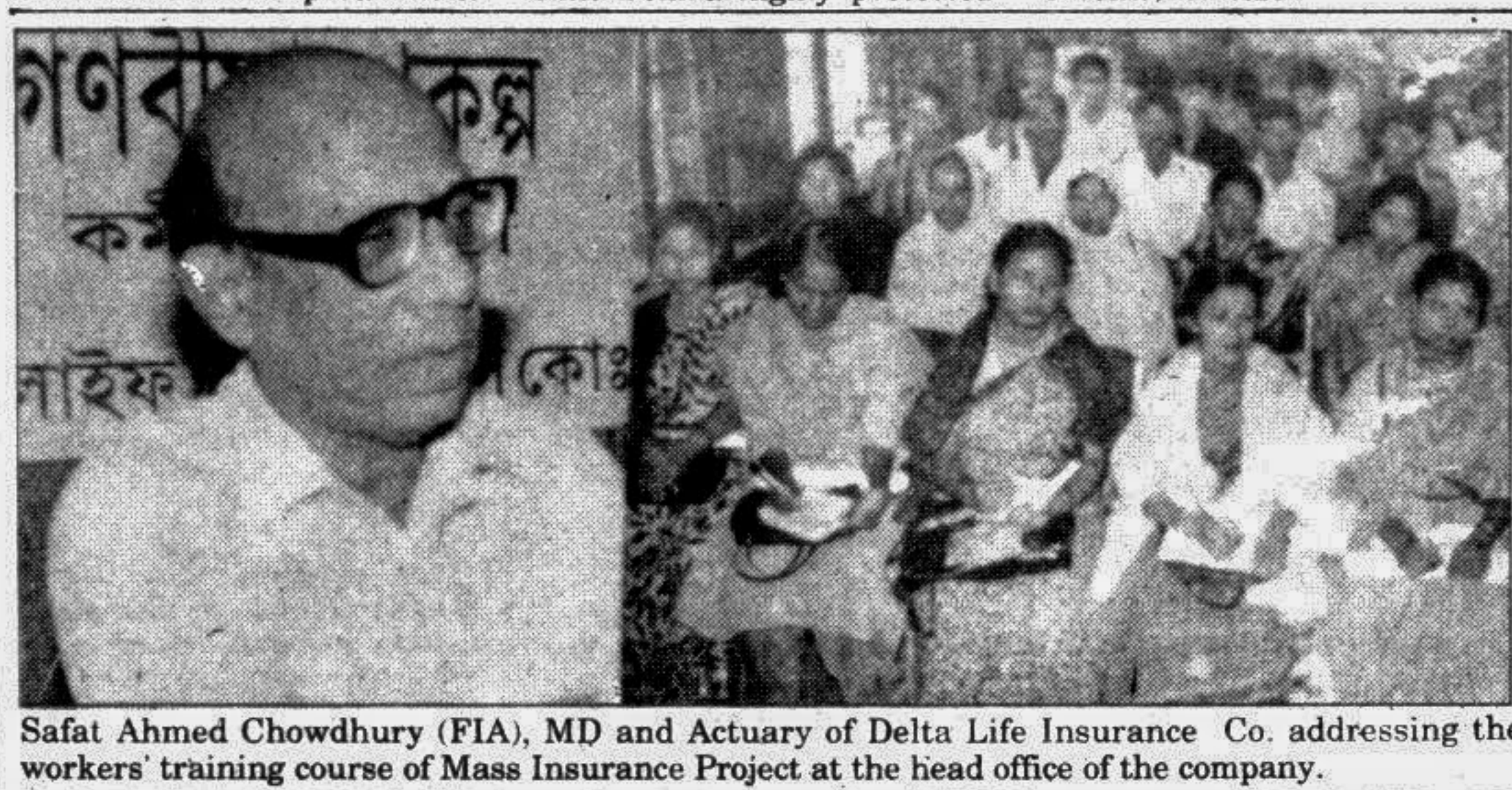
