Water may contain bacteria even after purification, JS told

Water may contain bacteria even after purification by chemicals, a senior minister told parliament yesterday, reports UNB.

In response to a supplementary during the question hour, LGRD Minister Barrister Salam Talukdar, however, did not say whether water with bacteria causes any harm to the consumers.

Bacteria is found in drinking water all over the world even after purification, he said.

Replying to Mirza Azam (Awami League). Barrister Talukdar told the House that the water bill in Dhaka city had been increased by 10 per cent per 1,000 litre, but it is still far from meeting the production cost.

Talukdar said the 10 per cent increase was necessary to meet the enhanced expenditure for the maintenance. The production cost of 1,000 litre water is Tk 4.37 and with 10 per cent rise in the water bill it will be reduced to Tk 4.10 which is still less than the actual production cost, he




