

One crushed under wheels

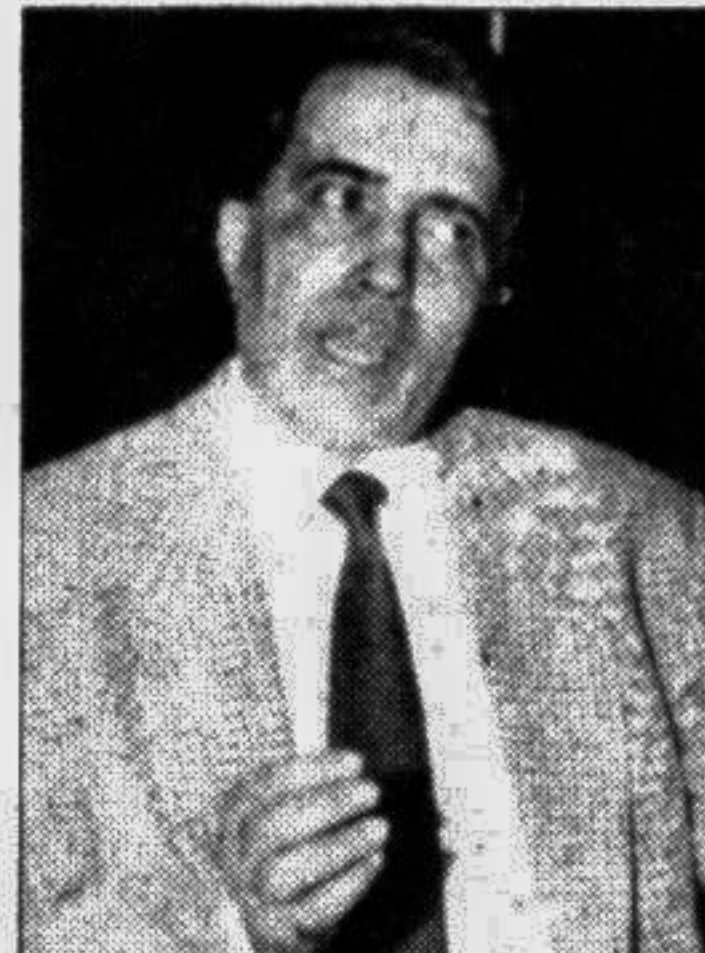

Two cyclone shelters built by donations of the expatriate Bangladeshis in Glasgow, UK will be opened tomorrow at Maheshkhali thana in Cox's Bazar district.

ence at the Jatiya Press Club yesterday M A Matin Khan, convener of the Bangladesh Relief Fund, which had sponsored construction of the shelters-cum-schools, said that David M Sanderson JP, Convener of the Strathclyde Regional Council of Scotland will formally inaugurate the cyclone shelters at Dhalghata and Matarbari unions of the district.

The two unions were among the worst affected areas in the tidal wave and cyclone on April 21, 1991.

After the disaster, doctors, engineers, students and businessmen living at Glasgow came forward with whatever assistance they could and generously donated to the Prime Minister's Relief Fund, Bangladesh Red Crescent Society and to the Bangladesh Youth Union.

Later, the expatriate Bangladeshis, led by MA Matin Khan, raised funds to build the permanent shelter-cum-school.

Regional book fair begins in Ctg Dec 18

The Greater Chittagong Hill Tracts Hill Students' Council yesterday announced its six-point charter of demands and fresh action programme with an aim to bring an end to the crisis at the Chittagong Hill Tracts.

The six-point demands include formation of an international investigation committee on Naniarchar killings, exekiplinary punishment of the persons involved in the killing, release of the tribal people arrested in connection with the Naniarchar case and withdrawal of 'false' cases filed against them, ensuring autonomy of the Hill Tracts.

The hill students disclosed these in a press conference held at the Madhu's Canteen at the Dhaka University in the afternoon.

The president of the council Prashit Bikash Khisha presented the key-note paper while Shaktiman Chakma, Shanchaya Chakma, Rupanta Chakma and Debashish Chakma attended the conference.

Describing the real picture of the Naniarchar killing on November 17 last the council leaders alleged that a vested quarter at the Chittagong Hill Tracts was trying to hinder the democratic movement of the hill students.

The hill students will observe mourning day and submit memorandum to the Prime Minister on December 7 and will observe total hunger strike at Dhaka, Rajshahi, Chittagong and the three hill districts on December 9.
