Massive scheme to cultivate potato

Dec 8: A massive scheme has been undertaken to bring 2.26 lakh acres of land under potato cultivation in 16 districts of northern zone in the current season, says UNB.

According to Agriculture Extension Department sources, 20,700 acres in Joypurhat, 25,935 acres in Bogra, 5,212 acres in Pabna, 15,067 acres in Naogaqn, 8,000 acres in Gaibandha, 29,743 acres in Rangpur, 8,472 acres in Kurigram, 20,254 acres in Nilphamari, 5,108 in Lalmanirhat, 8.645 acres in Sirajganj, 25.935 acres in Dinajpur, 21.486 acres in Thakurgaon, 6.669 acres in Panchagarh, 4.075 acres in Natore, 2,800 acres in C'nawabganj and 26,182 acres in Rajshahi were brought under the programme.

With the implementation of the scheme, it is expected that 10 lakh metric tons of potato will be produced in the districts. Mentionable that 8.45 lakh metric tons of potato were produced in the 16 district during the last year.

Bangladesh Agriculture Development Corporation (BADC) has supplied High Yielding Variety (HYV) seeds, pesticides, fertilisers and other necessary inputs among the growers at fair prices to make the scheme a success.

50 per cent of farmers have no land

Dec 8: Number of landless and unemployed people are increasing alarmingly in all five thanas of the district, official sources said, reports UNB.

According to a statistics, of the total population of 12 lakh about 50 per cent depend on agriculture, 15 - cent on different occupations and the rest are totally unemployed.

Sources said, among the farmers, 50 per cent are landless, 20 per cent have few acres of land and the rest have sufficient land property.

The number of landless farmers is increasing on account of erosion of rivers Piara and Biskhali. Besides due to recurrent floodings, cyclones and other natural calamities, every year a large number of people become landless.

Moreover, farmers having a few acres of land cannot afford to buy their necessary inputs like fertilizer, seeds, pesticides and even bullocks for cultivation due to abject poverty.


