IEB polls Dec 15

By Staff Correspondent. The elections to the office-bearers, council members and divisional committees, nine centres and four sub-centres of the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh (IEB) for the 1994-95 term will be held on December 15.

More than five thousand members of the IEB are expected to cast their ballots to elect office-bearers including eight executive posts in the headquarters and other executives and council members in different centres and sub-centres.

Engineer Md. Amad Hossain Khan, former Chairman of the Bangladesh Water Development Board, engineer Mohammad Abul Hayat, incumbent Vice President of IEB, and engineer Dr M Shahjahan, Vice Chancellor of BUET, are contesting for the post of IEB president.

Engineer SA Abul Hayat who is also a noted actor, engineer Mohammad Nurul Huda, Executive Engineer of Roads and Highways Department, and engineer Mohammad Ibrahim Miah, Executive Engineer of Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA) are contesting for the post of honorary general secretary.

Engineer M A K Azad, current honorary general secretary of IEB, has been elected unopposed the vice president (Academic and International Affairs).

Engineer Ruhul Matin, Executive Engineer of the Public Works Department (PWD) and engineer Sirajul Majid Mamun are contesting for the post of vice president (Administration and Finance).

Besides, two executive engineers of PWD — engineer Mohammad Abul Kashem and engineer A N H Akhter Hossain — are contesting for the post of vice president (Engineers Service and Social Welfare Committee).

A six-member central election committee, with engineer M A Kalam as Chairman, will conduct the polls.

The IEB increased the posts of vice president to three from two in the headquarters this year by amending its constitution. It also created three new posts of assistant honorary general secretary.
