The date for advance income tax payment for the 2nd quarter of the current financial year is December 15, 1993.

The advance income tax payable by the concerned taxpayer is to be paid through IT Form No. IT 31 (B) (amended) challan.

The taxpayers should pay the advance tax filling in the said challan form as usual by replacing the figure '74 (1)' with the figure '64' in as many places as it occurs in the form.

It may be mentioned that the financial limit of total income for payment of advance income tax for all classes of assesses is now Taka 1,00,000/=

All assesses concerned are requested to pay their advance income tax for the 2nd quarter of the current financial year relevant to the assessment year 1994-95 under this system by December 15, 1993. Simple interest @ 12% per annum will be leviable if the advance income tax is not paid or paid at a lesser amount than due.

Dr Engr Jamilur Reza Choudhury, president of the IEB, will preside over the session.

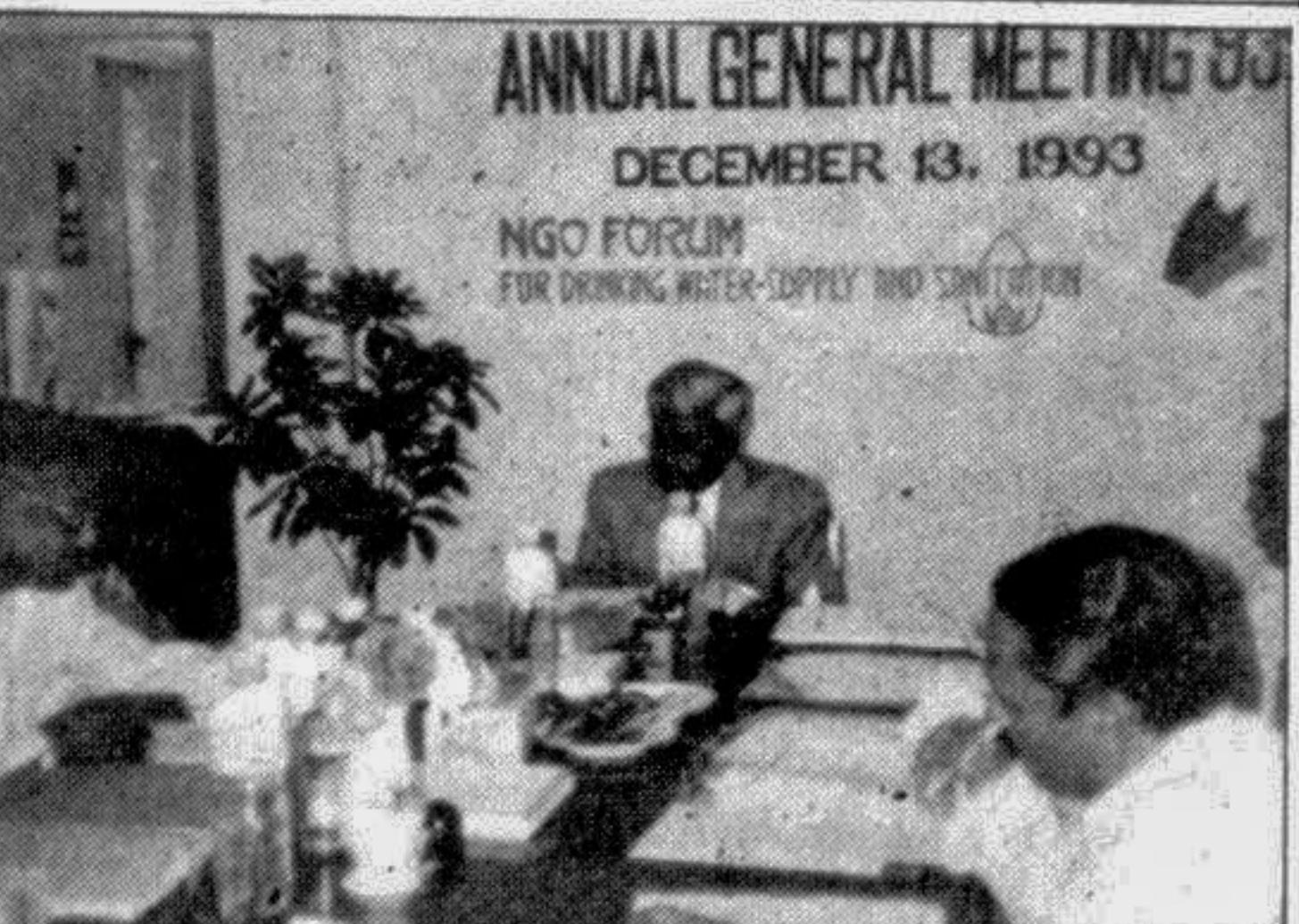
Seminar on geo-composite

New route for DU bus demanded

A group of students of the Dhaka University from Savar area yesterday demanded opening of a new bus route from university campus to Nabinagar immediately.

The students in a press conference yesterday also announced fresh programmes to press their demand.

Addressing the conference the students said that they

often fail to attend the classes in due time.

We sometimes even fail to attend the examinations in scheduled time as it is tough to reach the campus by using public transport from Savar, which is about 13 miles away from the campus, the students added.

Rafiqul Islam read out a paper in the conference held at the Madhusri Canteen on the DU campus.

It is learnt that more than 250 regular students, administrative officers and employees of the university live in Savar, Nabinagar areas.

Their action programmes include rally at the Aparajeo Bangla on December 18, sit-in in front of the office of the Vice Chancellor on December 20 and hunger strike on January 3, '94 if the bus route was not opened by this time.

Conditions for admission in DU relaxed
