Six bio-tech products for commercialisation

State Minister for Science and Technology Prof M A Mannan yesterday urged the private entrepreneurs to come forward in investing for manufacture of biotechnology products in the country, reports BSS.

Inaugurating a 10-day national workshop on biotechnology here Prof Mannan said at the directives of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia a biotechnology product development committee headed by him (Mannan) had already identified six biotechnology products for immediate commercialisation in the country.

The products are bio-fertiliser (rhizobium), yeast production for cattle, poultry and fish feed, bamboo production through tissue culture, potato seed production through micro propagation, animal vac-

cine production and biogas.

Biotechnology is any technique that uses living organisms or substances from those organisms to make or modify a product to improve plants or animals or to develop substances for specific uses.

Jointly organised by Biotechnology Research Centre, Dhaka University and UNESCO, the inaugural session of the workshop was held at the lecture theatre of the Department of Biotechnology in the Curzon Hall campus.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Emazuddin Ahmed, the function was also addressed by Dean of the Faculty of Biological Sciences of the university Prof M Shahadat Ali. Director of Biotechnology Research Centre Prof Mustafizur Rahman and Chairman of the Department of Microbiology Prof Nayyem Chowdhury.

In his presidential speech Prof Emazuddin Ahmed urged the scientists in the Curzon Hall campus to revitalise their self-confidence and make some remarkable breakthrough in the future, research works with best utilisation of the available resources.

A total of 15 scientists from different research laboratories and university departments are participating in the workshop while 14 resource persons from home and abroad will conduct the 10-day course.

42 arrested in city

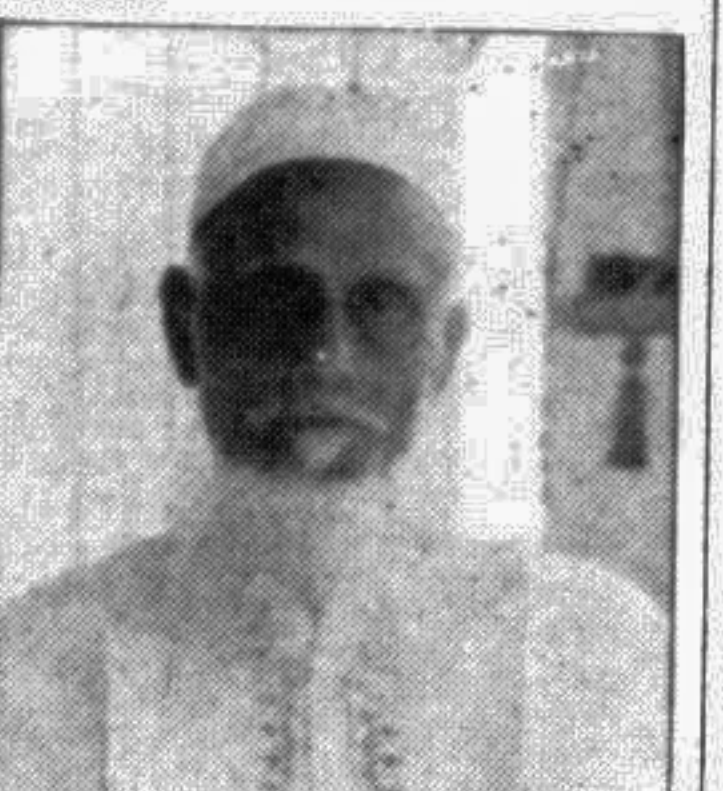
