Krishibid Instt EC asked to show cause

The court of Assistant Judge of the Second Court, Dhaka on Wednesday issued a restraining order on the activities of the newly elected central executive committee of the Krishibid Institution until further order.

The Court ordered the Election Commissioner of the Krishibid Institution polls, held on December 24 last, to show cause within three days of the order as to why the activities of the executive committee should not be restrained by a temporary injunction as prayed for by the plaintiff.

The Court ruling was issued following an application lodged by Krishibid M. Shahidul Islam against Krishibid AKM Mansur and others.

JUCSU polls by Jan 25 demanded

Different student bodies of the Jahangirnagar University yesterday demanded declaration of the date for university's central students' union JUCSU polls by January 25.

In a memorandum, submitted to the acting vice-chancellor of the university, the alliance of the eight left-leaning organisations Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO) made the demand for immediate announcement of JUCSU polls schedule.

The GCO members felt the JUCSU body as a must to uphold the problems of the students.

In another press conference, the Awami League backed Bangladesh Chhatra League BCL (M-I), also echoed the same demands.

Both GCO and BCL (M-I) alleged that the acting VC Prof Abul Hossain was avoiding the student leaders in an autocratic manner.

They also criticised the acting VC for not convening the Senate session as per university rules.

The student leaders urged all to unite against any amendment of the University Ordinance of 1973 which provided 'campus autonomy'.

The BCL (M-I) leaders criticised Prof Hossain for ignoring the student problems regarding transport, dining, residential dormitories, and increased fees for marksheets, transcripts and others.
