1. Sealed tenders in Bangladesh Form No. 2911 are hereby invited from the enlisted Special Class-I Contractors of PWD for the undermentioned works and will be received by the undersigned as well as by the Executive Engineer, SB Nagar PWD Division-I/I/II/Mohakhali/Eden Bldg./Dhaka PWD Division-I/II/III/IV/City PWD Divisional/Medical College/Azimpur/Motijheel/Savar/Mirpur/Resource/Maintenance PWD Division, Dhaka up to 12-00 Noon of 26-01-1994 and will be opened on the same day at 12-15 PM in presence of the intending tenderers who may like to remain present. Each tender shall be in a sealed cover with the name of work and groups superscribed on it. The works will be on a turn-key basis. No tender will be sold to a contractor/firm who has no VAT Registration.

The tender form may be purchased by the contractor, firm himself/themselves or his/their representative on production of authorised letter bearing the signature of the representative duly attested by the contractor/firm and VAT registration certificate. No tender form will be sold on the date of opening of tender.

4. The amount of earnest money as shown in serial-2 above in TC/PO/CD/DD from any scheduled Bank of Bangladesh validated not less than six months, or Pratirakha Sanchay Patra or BD Sanchay Patra duly pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer, Mohakhali PWD Division, Dhaka must accompany the tender. Those who have fixed deposit with this department must quote the reference to that effect and enclose the FD certificate obtained from the concerned Executive Engineer issued not earlier than 90 (Ninety) days from the date of dropping tender. Balance earnest money beyond the amount of FD shall have to be furnished along with the tender in the same manner as stated above. Earnest money in no other form will be accepted under any circumstances.

5. As the tender, comprises of more than one group, the fixed deposit holders are entitled to enjoy benefit of their fixed deposit for two groups only provided that either the cumulative amount of earnest money against the two groups is covered by the amount of fixed deposit or if the cumulative amount of earnest money against the two groups is more than the amount of fixed deposit the balance amount of earnest money is covered in usual manner as per Clause-4.

6. Rates are to be quoted both figures and in words in the 2nd page of BD Form No. 2911 or 1st page of condensed form on percentage basis i.e. "AT PAR% ABOVE/BELOW" than the rate shown in the schedule. The quoted rate shall not be more than 2 (two) digits beyond decimal point in any case.

7. While preparing comparative statement calculations of the amounts will be considered only 2 (two) digits after decimal points.

Yusuf for developing anti-diabetic agents from plants

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf yesterday said the government is committed to the WHO goal of ensuring "Health for all by the year 2000", reports UNB.

He was inaugurating a seminar on "Plant Materials as a Source of Anti-diabetic Agents" at the BIRDEM auditorium.

The inaugural session, the first international seminar of its kind, was addressed, among others, by Governor of Pakistan's province of Sindh Hakim Muhammad Saeed, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Emazuddin Ahmed and Director of International Programme in Chemicals Prof Rune Liminga.

Stressing the need for developing anti-diabetic agents from plants, the Health Minister said that finding such agents would be an encouraging thing in the fight against the global epidemic.

"For a country like Bangladesh, such a chronic disease creates a heavy burden on the family as well as on the government," Chowdhury said.

He paid tributes to late National Professor M Ibrahim, who had dedicated his life for establishing the BIRDEM (Bangladesh Institute of Research and Rehabilitation in Diabetes, Endocrine and Metabolic Disorders).

Hakim Muhammad Saeed, the Sindh Governor, speaking on the occasion, expressed concern at the growing incidence of diabetes, saying, "It is a formidable challenge for man to seek and unlock the secrets of herbs, efficacious enough to overcome the diabetes."

Saeed, who is the President of Hamdard Foundation, said that the plants on the earth have been found as the safest, stable and most natural medicine for man.

President of Bangladesh Diabetic Association, Alangir M A Kabir, who also spoke on the occasion, said: "Common men and women all over the world have profound faith in the efficacy of herbs."

Twenty other successful candidates were placed in the Second Class, while 11 others managed a Third Class.
