

## 9 huts gutted in Khulna

KHULNA, Jan 10: A devastating fire at the slum area of the Shipyard Mosque in the town gutted nine huts damaging property worth about Tk 6 lakh yesterday, reports UNB.

A woman, Samiran Bibi, 28, received serious burn injuries. She was admitted to the Khulna Sadar Hospital in a critical condition.

Witnesses said the fire ignited from a kitchen at about 7:30 pm and soon engulfed the area leaving some 100 slum dwellers homeless. Fire fighters rushed to the spot and put out the fire after an hour-long effort.

A case was filed with the local police.

## 141 bottles Phensidyl seized

## Two imposters nabbed

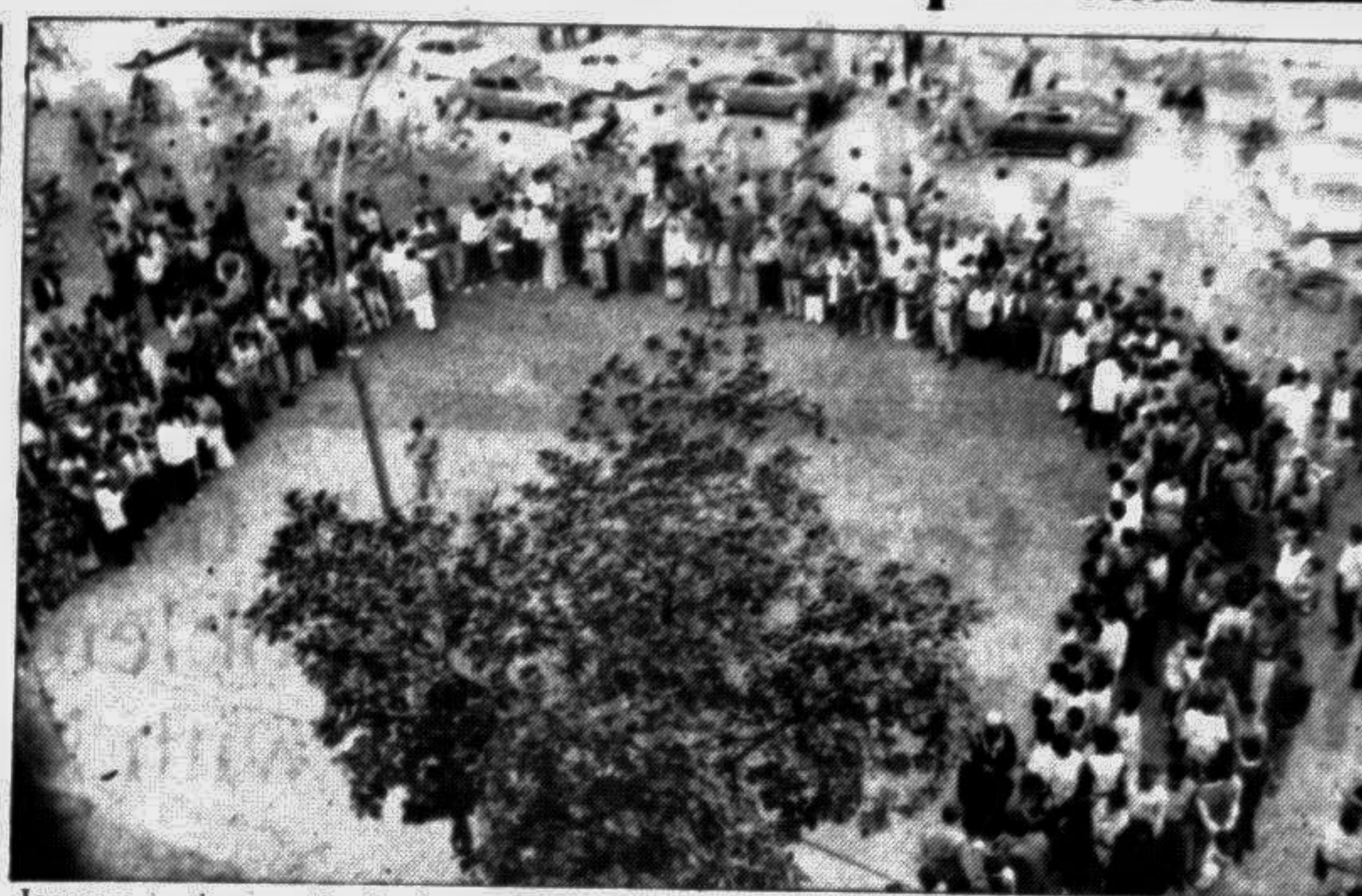
The City Special Branch with the cooperation of the Tejgaon Police arrested two imposters on January 6, a Dhaka Metropolitan Police press release said here Sunday.
