Hill people hold long march

A long march of tribal and non-tribal people yesterday reached the capital from Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) with a pledge to protect independence and integrity of the country, reports UNB.

Several hundred long marchers who began their journey on Wednesday from the three hill districts of Rangamati, Bandarban and Khagrachhari also demanded repeal of all discriminatory laws concerning the CHT and establishment of peace in the region.

The marchers were carrying placard and banners inscribed with slogans like 'Tribals — non-tribals are brothers, we want to live together.' 'Hold dialogue with India for peace in the Hill Tracts' and 'Ban activities of Pahari Chhatra Parishad.'

The march was organised by the Chittagong Hill Tracts National Coordination and Peace Council. A 70-member tribal cultural team accompanied the marchers.
