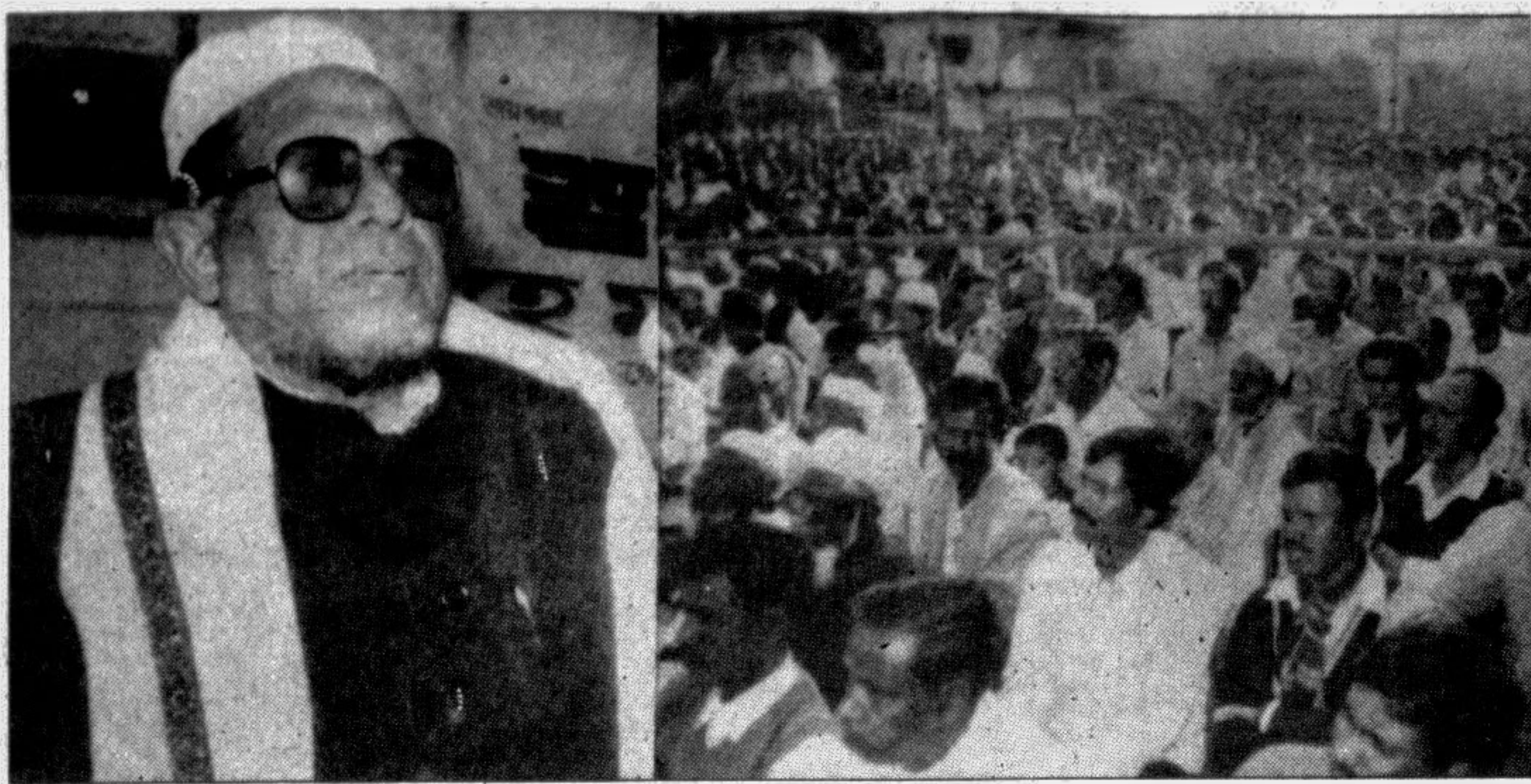


The best institutions
