Barua leaves behind his wife, five daughters and one son. His mortal remains will be cremated at his village crematory at Pingala under Patiya thana here, family sources said.

Emajuddin for implementation of research findings

Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed yesterday said that scholars in the universities of the country had carried out hundreds of researches which could help accelerate the development process, but those were shelved and neglected.

He was addressing a workshop on 'Research Activities in the Faculty of Biological Sciences' at Dhaka University yesterday.

Stressing the need on implementations of the research findings he said, 'the researchers of our country can make a significant progress even though our country has limited resources.'

The function presided over by the Chairman of the Soil Science Department Aminul Islam was also addressed, among others, by Dr Mohammad Shahadat.

"For instance, the university researchers have found a way to check latharism which is almost ubiquitous in Bangladesh, but implementation of the findings of the researchers is still a far cry," the DU VC said.

The Dhaka University is not full of negative incidents, positive things like a lot of researches are being done here but those are not highlighted in the mass media," Prof Emajuddin said.

To remove the obstacles for the implementation of research findings — there should be a close relationship between the scientists and the industrialists and business people, Dr Shahadat suggested.

In addition the negligible funds for research works, the researchers had to pay 80 per cent of the foreign allocations for procurement of chemicals as taxes, he pointed out.

15 thousand candidates for cadet college admission test
