## 18th PAMS concludes

The 18th Pacific Armies Management Seminar (PAMS XVIII) concluded in the capital Sunday with suggestions of setting up a separate section under the United Nations, comprising military experts, for conducting peacekeeping operations.

The seminar, participated by more than 150 senior military officials, from 35 countries in the Asia-Pacific region, also highlighted the need for analysing the present modus operandi and structure of the UN for peacekeeping efforts.

Jointly hosted by the Bangladesh Army and the US Army Pacific Command, the closing session of the 10-day seminar was addressed by the Commanding General, US Army Pacific Command Lieutenant General Robert L. Ord III and Chief of General Staff, Bangladesh Army Major General Mohammad Abdus Salam.

Speaking to the delegates, Lieutenant General L. Ord suggested the armies must have tough, realistic training to ensure success in the peacekeeping operations.

Major General Salam in his speech pointed out the need for increased security standards for Asia, home of two billion people, because of its ever growing economic activities.

The deliberations at the seminar would help establish a congenial atmosphere in Asia and the Pacific region through the process of friendship and understanding, he hoped.

Later, certificates were awarded among the participants of the seminar.

This is for the second time that Bangladesh has co-hosted the Pacific Armies Seminar. The latest one is also marked by the presence of delegates from all of the five permanent members of the UN Security Council. China has also participated in the 18th seminar for the first time.

## Card phone booth opens at Bahadur Shah Park

Posts and Telecommunications Minister Tariqul Islam said yesterday the introduction of card phone is a milestone in telecommunications sector to provide more modern telecom facilities to the subscribers, reports BSS.

The minister was formally inaugurating a card phone booth at Bahadur Shah Park in the city speaking with the Information Minister Barister Nazmul Huda, Secretary of Telecommunications Ministry Dr Shawkat Ali, Chairman Bangladesh Telephone and Telegraph Fazlur Rahman and Managing Director of Telephone Shilpa Sangstha (TSS). A R Saber were present.

So far 322 card phones including 196 in Dhaka are in operation throughout the country. The government earned revenue of more than Tk six crore from card phones by this time.

The minister later, inaugurated a card phone management centre at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar. This centre will effectively monitor the activities and functions of card phone centres set up in Chittagong, Dhaka, Khulna and Sylhet.

He also visited the test room and main distribution frame of Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Exchange and Telephone Sales Centre of TSS.

## JS body on Flood Ministry meet held

The parliamentary standing committee on the Ministry of Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control at a meeting in the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban here yesterday discussed the losses and damages caused by recurring floods in Greater Sylhet in a single monsoon, reports BSS.

Irrigation Minister M. Majid-Ul-Haque was in the chair. The committee was informed that as per directives of the Irrigation and Flood Control Ministry, the Water Development Board prepared and submitted a report on the Greater Sylhet District flood control.

## Treadle pump becoming popular among farmers

Treadle pump, an indigenous irrigation method, is fast becoming popular among farmers across Bangladesh with some 8,00,000 units of the manual water pumps have already been sold in last ten years, reports UNB.

Last year alone, some 1,60,000 treadle pumps were sold and the company responsible for its marketing said it was receiving more and more queries about the pump from interested farmers from all over the country.

Ever since the pump was first innovated and introduced in 1984, it has slowly becoming popular.

## Nat'l policy on children mooted

The government will shortly adopt the national policy on children with a view to upholding the rights and privileges of children of the country, reports BSS.

State Minister for Social Welfare Fazlur Rahman said this while addressing as chief guest the concluding ceremony of the two-day workshop on "Integrated planning for promotion of child rights in Bangladesh" in the city.

He said a draft policy on it had already been finalised and it would be placed before parliament. The importance for such a policy was felt to integrate the government and non-government initiatives for protection of the rights of the children," he added.

The workshop was organised by the Maitree Parishad, a local NGO, in cooperation with "Save the Children Fund-Australia" at the Caritas auditorium.

Executive director of Proshika (Muk) Dr Kazi Faruque Ahmed and executive director of Maitree Parishad Mostafizur Rahman also spoke on the occasion. Vice-Chairman of the parishad Firoz M Hasan was in the chair.

Fazlur Rahman stressed the need for a coordinated efforts of all including the government and others for ensuring progress of the country in all fields.

"We have limited resources but still we must try together to achieve our common goal of

development," he said with a call for dedication of all towards the efforts for speedy development of the country.

Four keynote papers on street children, child labour, trafficking of children and orphan children were presented during four sessions of the two-day workshop.

In all, 15 recommendations were adopted at the closing ceremony with a call for stopping child labour, reducing birth rate, giving children access to universal education.
