Development of drainage system of RCC

Taka 50 crore master plan prepared

RAJSHAHI, Jan 24: A master plan for overall development of drainage system of Rajshahi City Corporation (RCC) has been prepared and the feasibility report of the project has already been submitted to the government for its implementation.

An official source told BSS that the government will provide Taka fifty crore for completion of the project.

Work on the drainage project will start from March next.

Ten traffic signals, first of its kind in the city, will be set up at different important places at a cost of Taka thirty lakh and the work on the scheme will begin from mid-

February, the source added.

Rajshahi City Corporation has undertaken two thousand various development schemes during the last three years for the benefit of the city dwellers. Of them one thousand two hundred schemes including development of roads, lanes and bylanes, installation of sodium lights in different city streets, improvement of water supply and graveyards have already been completed. Work on remaining eight hundred development schemes are going on.

The source said that the government has already provided Taka thirty-four crore for completion of the schemes.
