tem and also establish mother trees within the locality as future source of seeds, grafts, buds, cutting etc.

EXPECTED IMPACT OF THE VFFP PROGRAMME

The VFFP has the potentials to set impact at various level from household level to the national level as mentioned below:

At household level:

- Regular supply of fuel & fodder from their own resource base.
- Creation of asset for the time of their need
- Alternate asset to save their valuable fruit & timber trees
- Ability to save crop residues and animal dung and return those to their agricultural land.
- Increased biomass for consumption
- Ability to keep livestock and/or their draught animal through availability of fodder and animal nutrition.
- Increased nutrition (fruits).
- Increased income.

At social/community level:

- Awareness building on tree planting, care, management and maintenance.

PROJECT LOCATION

The programme covers an area of 242 blocks of Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE) scattered in 9 districts (Dinajpur, Bogra, Natore, Rajshahi, Kushtia, Mymensingh, Projpur, Comilla and Chittagong).

WORKING STRATEGY

Based on experiences during first four years it has been realized that to achieve the stated goals and objectives the project needs to ensure that the rural farming household and the community gains:

- access to quality planting stock of wider range of desired/preferred, potentially improved varieties and species.
- access to technical know-how on tree planting, protection care and management.
- access to professional and technical skills for tree improvement and renovation.
- access to other social resources (Informations, training etc.)

On Environment:

- preservation natural environmental equilibrium contribution in bio-diversity.
- contribution in areas of wild life by ensuring proper habitat.

On Livestock resources:

- livestock development for draught animal and milking cows
- Availability of draught power at the correct time of season
- increased availability of fodder and animal nutrition.

On Agriculture & land resources:

- land development (productivity and fertility) through return of crop residues, animal waste and compost, leaf fall and in-situ nitrogen fixation.
- Improved agro-ecology
- Reduction in soil erosion
- maintenance of land moisture and micro-environment.

SUMMARY OF RESULTS ACHIEVED

During the year 1987-1993 The Homestead Programme was Participated by 70,983 and Cropland Programme was Participated by 3,221. Number of trees planted during this time was 932,786 in homestead and 169,869 in cropland.

ogy, incorporates institutional changes, plus the staffing and investment necessary to reach goals and targets. Scenario 1 continues to involve government departments and agencies directly in Programme implementation as well as supervision. Scenario 2 presumes an entrepreneurial basis and direct implementation by Programme participants with only government monitoring and coordination. Scenario 1 represents what is optimistically possible with the existing forestry system, while Scenario 2 measures what is potentially achievable under optimum conditions. There are a multitude of positions between these two alternatives for Government to select.

Programme designed especially for direct and visual public benefit involve environment management, participatory forestry, non wood forest products, wood energy conservation and bamboo development. Every citizen of Bangladesh benefits from an improved environment. Participatory benefit Programme are the base for assisting government's poverty alleviation efforts. Energy conservation lowers the demand for fuelwood or animal dung; reducing the pressure on forests and improving agriculture production. The bamboo development Programme help to offset effects of forecast reductions in bamboo, a major home building materials for the rural population.

Conclusions

An analysis of the relevance of participatory forestry and agro-forestry practices for Bangladesh, the achievements of the Village and Farm Forestry Programme of SDC, current Government Policies and the proposals contained in the Forestry Master Plan as far as they relate to people's participation in forestry and agro-forestry practices, the following conclusions may be drawn.

- Participatory Forestry and Agroforestry Practices need to be adopted on a wider scale to ensure integrated and multiple land use and also to achieve major socio-economic objectives.
- Village and Farm Forestry Programme of SDC has evolved into a viable and replicable model of nursery development and plantation in the rural areas.
- VFFP deserves to be considered as a serious Programme to achieve proclaimed socio-economic objectives like — poverty alleviation, income generation, and re-generate the self-confidence of the rural poor.
- VFFP deserves to be experimented by all relevant NGOs for incorporation in their own Programme.
- The government should also examine the suitability of VFFP Programme for adoption in its social forestry Programme.

A working group consisting of representatives from major NGOs, SDC, partner NGOs in VFFP and the Ministry of Environment and Forest should examine the replicability of VFFP on a national scale by all concerned.

The government is committed to people's participation in forestry sector.

Application of the commitment of the government to involve people in the forestry sector needs to be expanded.

The government should also encourage people's participation at both individual and corporate levels.

People's participation should be extended to the reserve forest plantations and joint management.

The Forestry Master Plan has come up with some suggestions in this field which need to be considered seriously by the government for implementation.

NGO initiatives like VFFP can be mutually beneficial for NGOs, government and private sector participation both at individual and organizational level.

one of the fastest growing areas of demand in the nursery business is for seedlings for woodlots, mixed tree gardens and other block plantings of trees on high khetland. Given the decline in rice prices coupled with the unabated demand for tree products, who is to say that these farmers' decision is not the economically rational one? All of this is happening without the project having to decide whether or not it should be happening. Maybe that is the real meaning of 'farmer-driven'.

In planning for the future, the eminently successful VFFP programme is now looking for ways to feed the fire of innovation that it has sparked. Perhaps the main lesson in all of this is:

If you want to have an unusually successful tree planting programme, the farmers do it.
