## Waqf Admn to earn about Tk 1.57 cr

The Waqf Administration is expected to earn about Tk 1.57 crore during the fiscal year 1993-94, reports BSS.

The earning of the administration for the year 1992-93 was Tk 70 lakh.

This was informed at the Waqf Conference-94 held yesterday at the office premises of Waqf Administration in Dhaka with Minister for Religious Affairs Mohammad Keramat Ali in the chair.

Among others, Secretary, Ministry of Religious Affairs, Abdul Hamid Chowdhury and Waqf Administrator Mohd Nizamuddin spoke in the conference.

It was informed in the conference that there were about 1.50 lakh Waqf estates all over the country out of which about 15 thousand estates have so far been brought under Waqf enlistment. The rest of the Waqf
