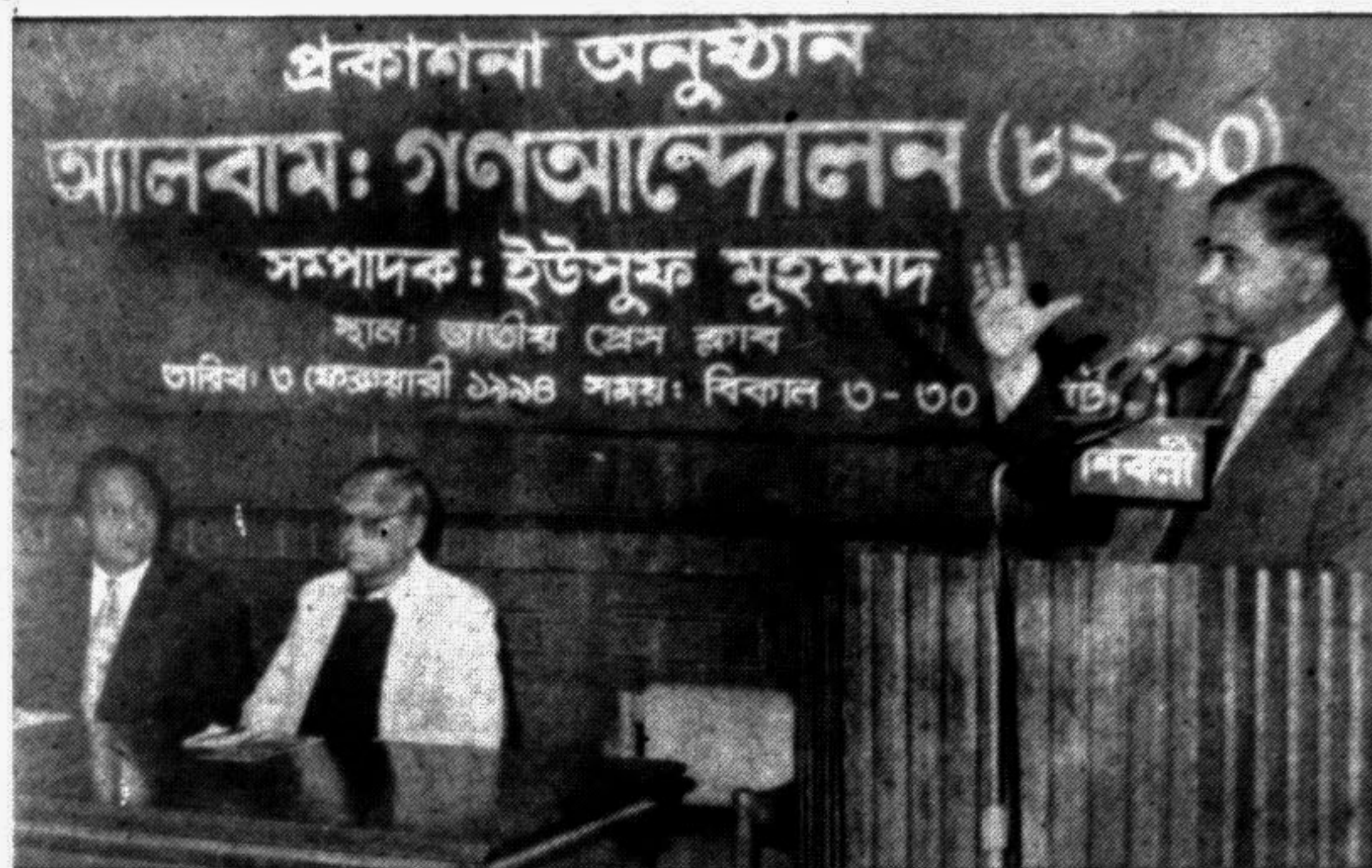

Waqf Admn to earn about Tk 1.57 cr

The Waqf Administration is expected to earn about Tk 1.57 crore during the fiscal year 1993-94, reports BSS.

The earning of the administration during the year 1992-93 was Tk 70 lakh.

This was informed at the Waqf Conference-94 held yesterday at the office premises of Waqf Administration in Dhaka with Minister for Religious Affairs Muhammad Keramat Ali in the chair.

Among others, Secretary, Ministry of Religious Affairs, Abdul Hamid Chowdhury and Waqf Administrator Mohd Nizamuddin spoke in the conference.

It was informed in the conference that there were about 1.50 lakh Waqf estates all over the country out of which about 15 thousand estates have so far been brought under Waqf enlistment. The rest of the Waqf

property would be enlisted under Waqf Administration through concerted effort.

Stress was given for preparation of an effective Waqf law by amending the existing laws to make the Waqf Administration more powerful and dynamic in future.

Emphasis was also given for launching a crash programme for enlisting the remaining Waqf estates under Waqf Administration within shortest possible time. Measures should also be taken to resist the illegal sale and encroachment on Waqf property.

The religious minister, in his address, urged all concerned to work with missionary zeal to raise Waqf income so that increased humanitarian programmes could be undertaken to help the distressed, helpless and the ill-fated people of the country.

Inter-agency workshop for UN staff ends

A five-day long inter-agency workshop, began on January 30, on Practice of Management Principles for United Nations staff in Bangladesh concluded yesterday in Dhaka, says a press release.
