

The rate of international tourists arrival in Bangladesh has increased by about 15 per cent in 1993 compared to that in the previous year says a press release.

In 1993 total tourist arrivals stood at 1,26,785 while that was 1,10,475 in 1992. Meanwhile the statistics show that foreign exchange earnings from this sector has also shown upward trend during 1993.

The foreign exchange earnings until October last year was Tk 49.18 crore while it was Tk 32.91 crore in the year 1992.
