Three persons including a young woman died in separate incidents in the city Tuesday.

Two of the victims died in road accidents while the young woman succumbed to burn injuries.

Shahida Begum, wife of Shamsu Mia reportedly caught fire from a kerosene lamp Monday evening at Keraniganj. She was rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital where she breathed her last Tuesday.

At Kamalapur, an ageing man of about 60, Badaha, was knocked down and seriously injured by a speeding minibus Monday night. He later died in the early hours Tuesday.

On the outskirts of the city at Pagla, one Razzak Hossain received fatal injuries when a truck clashed him to the ground. Razzak died at the DMCH after admission at 1 pm yesterday.

All the bodies were sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.
