Six killed in road mishaps

Six people were killed in separate road accidents in the city and Narayanganj Saturday.

An elderly woman was run over by a speeding bus near the city's Khilgaon level crossing in the afternoon. The victim Sabura Khatun, 65, died on the spot.

In another incident, Mohammed Mozammel Hossain Khasru, 16, was crushed under the wheels of a speeding minibus at Harirampur area, Mirpur, about 4:00 am.

An unidentified pedestrian was killed on the spot when a speeding truck knocked him down at Sector 4, Uttara about 3:00 am.

Another unidentified person was crushed under the wheels of a speeding truck at Gabtoli about 4:00 am. He was immediately sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where the doctors declared him dead.

A day labourer was seriously injured when a truck ran over

him at Shampur, Narayanganj, at about 4:00 am.

The victim, Mohammad Abdur Razzak, 30, was rushed to the DMCH where he succumbed to his injuries soon after admission.

In another road mishap, Mohammed Zamir Hossain, 22, was killed when a speeding minibus knocked him down at Tarabo, Demra about 9:00 am.

Police sent all the bodies to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.
