Cancer claims 2 lakh lives every year

Director of "The Health Cycle" Calcutta Dr Raj Vajpeyi

Director of Cancer Institute and Research Hospital Prof Dr Md Abdul Hai presided over the symposium.

The speakers said proper early detection through mass awareness about cancer, treatment, rehabilitation and preventive measures can reduce the number of cancer patients.

The commonest sites of cancer in men are lung 21 per cent, oesophagus 5, oral cavity 12, larynx 13, gastrointestinal tract 6, leukemia & lymphoma 8 and others 41 per cent. In women breast 17 per cent, oesophagus 4, oral cavity 13, uterus 24, larynx 2, gastrointestinal tract 4, leukemia & lymphoma 5, others 35 per cent.

Cancer can be prevented by avoiding smoking and chewing betel-leaf with tobacco ingredients, they said. One third of the cancer cases can be prevented, one third can be cured and palliation is possible with relief of pain for the rest.
