Cancer claims 2 lakh
lives every year

Some 8 lakh people are suffering from cancer, a deadly disease, which takes a toll of about 2 lakh lives every year in the country, reports UNB.

This was revealed in a symposium on "Prevention of Cancer, Early Detection, Treatment and Rehabilitation" at UNIC auditorium yesterday afternoon.

Organised by Impact Foundation Bangladesh in cooperation with United Nations Information Centre (UNIC), the symposium was addressed by Chairman of the foundation Shafat Ahmed Chowdhury. Oncologist of Bangladesh Cancer Society Prof S H Haq, its Secretary General Prof Dr Samir Kumar Sarma, Oncologist of Thakurpukur Cancer Hospital and Welfare Home in Calcutta Dr Rati Vajpey and Chief Pathologist and Medical

Director of "The Health Cyt" Calcutta Dr Raj Vajpey. Director of Cancer Institute and Research Hospital Prof Dr Md Abdul Hai presided over the symposium.

The speakers said proper early detection through mass awareness about cancer, treatment, rehabilitation and preventive measures can reduce the number of cancer patients.

The commonest sites of cancer in men are lung 21 per cent, oesophagus 5, oral cavity 12, larynx 13, gastrointestinal tract 6, leukemia & lymphoma 8 and others 41 per cent. In women, breast 17 per cent, oesophagus 4, oral cavity 13, uterus 24, larynx 2, gastrointestinal tract 4, leukemia & lymphoma 5, others 35 per cent.

Cancer can be prevented by avoiding smoking and chewing betel-leaf with tobacco ingredients, they said. One third of the cancer cases can be prevented, one third can be cured and palliation is possible with relief of pain for the rest.

The second death anniversary of Nurul Momen Khan alias Mihir, former secretary to the government, will be held today, reports BSS.

Khan was secretary in different ministries and died of heart attack two years ago in Japan while on an official visit there as the secretary, Ministry of Youth and Sports.
