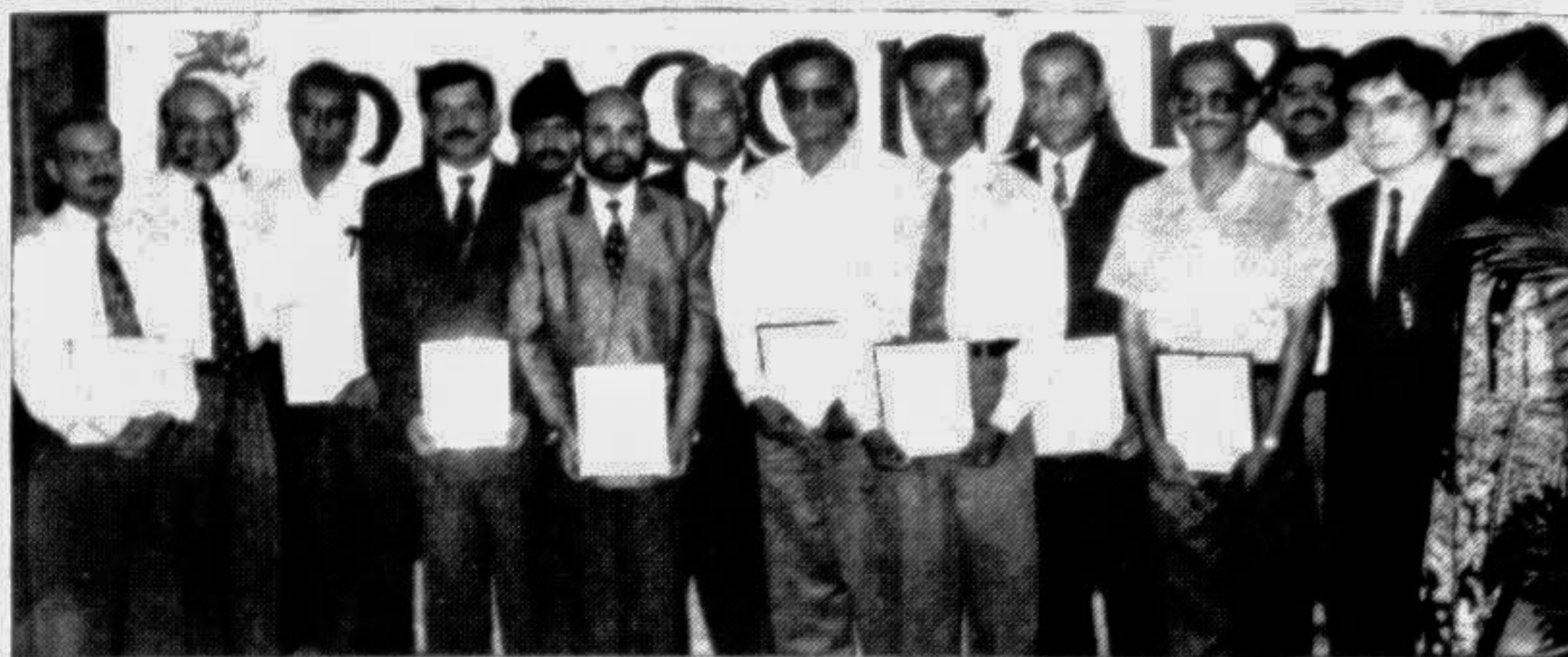

Presided over by Justice Kamaluddin Hussain, the meeting paid deep respect to shaheed Dhirendranath Dutta for his pioneering role in establishing Bengali as one of the state languages of undivided Pakistan. They also remembered his contribution as a great parliamentarian and champion for upholding the cause of the Bengali nation.

Attended by a large number of intellectuals, admirers and relatives of shaheed Dutta, a number of people including Syed Nazmuddin Hashim, Noorjahan Morshed and Arona Gonn narrated their personal memories with Dutta.
