Justice Syed Mohammad Hossain was the eldest son of late Syed Tasoodouq Hossain, the then district and sessions judge during British rule in India and was also a judge during early period of Pakistan.

Justice Syed Mohammad Hossain was born in a very educated and respected family.

Justice Syed Mohammad Hossain was Chairman of the International Law Association and was Chairman of the Amnesty International Bangladesh branch. He was also the Chairman of the International Commission of Justice Bangladesh branch.

Justice Syed Mohammad Hossain died on April 2.

On the occasion of his death anniversary Qurankhwani will be held at the residence of Begum Syed Mohammad Hossain at 38, Dilu Road, Moghbazar.



VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) country office in Bangladesh seeks applications from Bangladeshi nationals for a Personnel/Administrative Officer's position which has fallen vacant. Women are particularly encouraged to apply. Broad responsibilities include:

1. Reporting to the Operations Manager, supports the Resident Representative in all aspects of personnel management (including recruitment, job classification, HRD, counselling, staff relations, etc.) and operations management (which includes general services, travel/protocol, communications and procurement/inventory) in the UNDP office and for all other UN staff for which the UN Resident Co-ordinator is responsible.
2. Prepares and maintains a Human Resource Development plan for national staff of the UNDP office that covers recruitment, placement, career development and training;
3. Coordinates all training activities for the UNDP office with other local UN Missions, matching office needs with individual career goals and needs;
4. Interprets, clarifies and applies policies and procedures on personnel, harmonising to the greatest extent possible with other UN organisations with offices in Bangladesh;
5. Supervises the personnel administration of locally recruited staff, including salary administration for local staff; co-ordinates all the procedures/steps involved in the recruitment, appointment and promotion of locally recruited staff, including supporting related management/ consultative bodies (local Appointments & Promotions Board, local Management Review Group, etc.);
6. Monitors the movement and leave of internationally recruited staff and provides administrative/personnel services for them;
7. Assists UNDP Headquarters in the administration of internationally recruited staff, including common system matters (salary surveys, cost-of-living surveys, DSA reviews, etc.)
8. Supervises the arrangement of freight forwarding and customs clearance of project supplies and equipment, as well as of personal effects of internationally recruited personnel;
9. Supervises the management of office premises, other facilities (e. g. UN clinic, housing), supplies and equipment; maintains administrative records and supervises the registry and communications systems;
10. Briefs and assists international and national personnel on arrival in Bangladesh on administrative matters and other services (housing, banking, transport, etc.); provides advice to project and office personnel, as required;
11. Participates in setting up arrangements for the protection of personnel and property of the United Nations system; prepare and maintain contingency plans for medical and other emergencies;
12. Assists in developing and maintaining administrative and personnel management information systems for the office, including implementing UNDP corporate software packages;
13. Performs any other duties which the supervisor may assign.

Salary ranges from Tk. 370,170 - 431,050 net per annum plus children allowances and other admissible benefits as per UN rules.

QUALIFICATIONS
