BNP, AL creating crisis in country : GF

Leaders of Gano Forum yesterday accused both the ruling BNP and opposition Awami League for creating an uncertain situation in the country.

At a press conference, the Gano Forum leaders pointed out that while the government has taken coercive measures to resist the movement of some of the opposition parties over the Magura election results, the main opposition party had joined hands with the party of the past autocrat and a communal party for its interest.

The press conference addressed by Shahed Ali, was attended among others by Nurjahan Khurshid, Motiur Rahman, Ziaul Haq, Gen (ret) Khalilur Rahman, Saifuddin Manik, Kamal Haider and Rabeya Straj.

"Through the fall of the past autocrat the people of the country expected that there will be free and fair election in the future and there will be an end to killings, vote dacoity,

media coup and such things," said Shahed.

"But even after three years, the expectation of the people remained unfulfilled. The country has fallen into a crisis due to the absence of political leadership," he added.

The Gano Forum leaders criticising the role of the sangsad said that Parliament had virtually become ineffective due to lack of minimum understanding among its members.

They observed that the political parties continued to shelter terrorists and black money holders.

"Even the Election Commission is failing to play an independent and neutral role in the face of pressure from the government party and the opposition," the leaders pointed out.

The Forum urged both the government and opposition parties to play responsible roles and uphold the democratic spirit.

'Ad rates for newspapers to be fixed'

A meeting of the Bangladesh Sangbadpatra Parishad, representatives of newspapers and advertisement agencies on Friday decided that all newspapers would inform the BSP about their fixed rates of advertisements and the BSP would inform the Ad agencies about these rates.

The advertisement rates for all newspapers will also be fixed.

The meeting, presided over by BSP president Kazi Shahed Ahmed, said the commission for Ad agencies would be 15 per cent.

It was decided that the newspapers can contact the advertisers directly but the advertisements must come through the Ad agencies at the fixed rates.

The Ad agencies will pay the advertisement bills on time failing which they will have to pay interest on the bills at bank rates.

The meeting demanded that the government advertisements be distributed through the Ad agencies, and not through the DPP. The DPP would also have to increase the insertion of advertisements.

The meeting also demanded new rates for government advertisements.
