

New timings for inter-dist trains

Timings of some interdistrict trains running in the eastern region of the country has been rescheduled from *Pahela Baisakh*, the first day of Bengali year 1401, reports UNB.

In the new schedule the Dhaka-Chittagong interdistrict train *Provati* will run according to the new timing and will halt at Bhairab Bazar, Brahmanbaria, Akhaura, Comilla, Laksham and Feni.

Interdistrict *Purabi* will run non-stop as per usual timing. *Urimi Express* of the same route will run as usual but now have an additional stoppage at Laksham.

Parabat Express operating in the Dhaka-Sylhet route will run according to the new time schedule. The train's stoppage at Brahmanbaria will be withdrawn under the new casting.

The *Upokul Express* in the Dhaka-Noakhali route will now stop at Brahmanbaria station.

The *Shoban* category seats will be introduced in the Dhaka-Sylhet *Jayintikka Express*.
