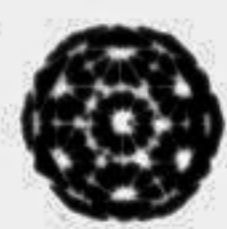

IFRC to build 120 cyclone shelters

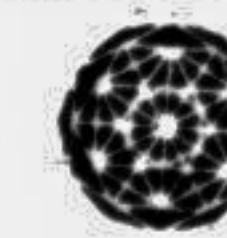
