## 'Bangla Academy incident' indecent

The Sammita Sangkritik Jote leaders Thursday protested against the Bangla Academy authorities' attempt not to allow Dr Ahmad Sharif to present his key-note paper at the seminar organised by the academy on the occasion of Bangla new year.

A press release issued by the Jote said, Jote president Faye Ahmed himself went to the academy to register the protest. Talking on the issue with the academy secretary and other officials, Faye Ahmed observed that it was 'indecent on the academy's part to disallow Sharif to present his article because he had been requested by the academy authorities to write the article, the press release said.

Faye Ahmed also observed that the ministry concerned had violated the autonomy of the academy by interfering with the organisation's academic affairs.

## Jabbar Khan's 11th anniversary of death today

The 11th death anniversary of Justice Abdul Jabbar Khan, former Speaker of the Pakistan National Assembly, will be observed today. On that day in 1983, Khan died at the age of 83, says a press release.

On the occasion, arrangements have been made for milad mahfil at 9, New Eskaton, Dhaka and his village home at Babuganj, Barisal.

## Mosir Rahman's anniversary of death today

The 23rd death anniversary of noted Advocate and Minister of Jukta Front Cabinet Mosir Rahman will be observed today at the deceased village home at Shinghajhupi, Jessore after Zohr prayers, says a press release.

On this day in 1971 he was brutally killed by the Pakistani army at the Jessore Cantonment.

To observe the day a milad mahfil, and Qurankhwani will be held followed by a feeding of the destitute.

## City's 1,500 telephones out of order

Some 1,500 telephones in the city's Dilkusha and Dhanmondi areas went out of order as rain water entered into the telephone cables due to heavy shower in last two days, reports UNB.

The T & T people have started working round the clock to restore the telephones — about 800 in Dilkusha commercial area and 700 at road nos 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Dhanmondi residential area.

It is hoped that the telephones would be restored as early as possible. Bangladesh T & T Board regrets the temporary inconvenience of the valued subscribers.

## Private Clinics Bill needs further scrutiny
