joyed democracy in this country, we need a democratic culture now," Prof Chowdhury added.

Regarding the Special Powers Act, which was severely criticised at the seminar, Chowdhury said, "I would not defend the Act. But you should also see how many times this government used this law against the people."

Regarding free and fair elections, he commented, "Everybody should abandon the attitude: Right if I win, wrong if I lose. We must respect the Election Commission's role for holding polls and we must respect the democratic processes in order to gain better fruits in the future."

Mainul Hossain, rejecting the idea of a caretaker government, suggested, "Perhaps, the ruling party can dissolve the Cabinet a month ahead of the elections as a convention. In the absence of the cabinet, the President would exercise the executive power of the state."

The speakers criticised the government for not separating the judiciary from the administration although this has

been an age-old demand.


The speakers also stressed formulation of better laws through elaborate discussions among the people's representatives, repeal of the Special Powers Act and Anti-Terrorism Act.

Judicious implementation of the law and practice of democratic norms by all political parties.

Prof Chowdhury, in solidarity with the other speakers, said "The educated and brighter people do not join political parties," they only advise them."

Regarding the standard of human rights in Bangladesh vis-a-vis western values, the Deputy Leader blasted the western countries saying, "The Americans preach their values of human rights — but remember, who killed the natives of their continent? Or what about the Canadians or the Australians? Nobody has a clean record of human rights."

"The situation in Bangladesh had never been worse than that of the western countries. But, whatever situation we may have now, will be better tomorrow," Chowdhury added.
