- Bids are to be dropped in the tender box between 3rd to 8th May, 1994 during the Government office hours. The box will be placed in the office room of the undersigned during the same period. The tender box will be opened on the 8th of May right at 11 am in presence of tenderers, if any.
- Earnest money at the rate of 2½% (two and half percent) of the total quoted amount is to accompany the bid by way of draft or pay order drawn in favour of the undersigned.
- The supporting documents should include among others—
 (i) Copy of the trade licence and in case of a joint stock company certificate of incorporation;
 (ii) Copy of the income tax certificate;
 (iii) Copy of the VAT registration certificate;
 (iv) Name and qualification of the technical staff of the firm designated for maintenance and servicing of the supplied computers during the warranty period;
 (v) Manufacturer's Literature in original only for the main items.
- The successful bidder will be required to supply the equipments and install them along with the softwares on 'turn key basis' within 7 (seven) days from the receipt of the Supply Order.
