21. **EPSCS-C/A-9/93**: 1 (One) permanent post of Research Investigator for the Food Planning and Maintenance Unit under the Ministry of Food.

Taka-2,300-4,480/- plus other allowances/benefits as admissible under the rules.

Second Class Master's Degree from a recognised University, preferably in Economics or Statistics or Agri-economics or Mathematics or Agronomy or Soil Science.

Not exceeding 30 years on 1st April, 1994. This limit will be relaxed for persons already in Government Service.

Women candidate are also eligible to apply for the post.
