Secretary, Bangladesh Public Service Commission Secretariat, Dhaka, invites applications for the following post:

21. **BPCS-C/A-9/93 : 1 (One) permanent post of Research Investigator for the Food Planning and Maintenance Unit under the Ministry of Food.**

**Pay** : Taka-2,300-4,480/- plus other allowances/benefits as admissible under the rules.

**Qualification** : Second Class Master's Degree from a recognised University, preferably in Economics or Statistics or Agri-economics or Mathematics or Agronomy or Soil Science.

**Age** : Not exceeding 30 years on 1st April, 1994. This limit will be relaxed for persons already in Government Service.

Women candidate are also eligible to apply for the post.

**General important informations:**

- Upper age limits are also relaxable for freedom fighter candidates up to 32 years for the post for which the maximum age is less than 32 years. A released/retired non-commissioned armed forces personnel will get the benefit of age relaxation for Government jobs up to a maximum period the person has actually served the armed forces subject to condition that a released/retired non-commissioned Armed Forces personnel who has attained the age of superannuation will not be eligible for recruitment to Civil posts.
