Caretaker govt can't ensure fair polls : Dr Kamal

Gano Forum president Dr Kamal Hossain said his party does not believe that a caretaker government can ensure free and fair election although the opposition parties have raised such a demand.

Dr Kamal stressed the need for a national consensus on issues like caretaker government for the sake of democracy.

Addressing a rally in the city on Sunday he said the Election Commission should be given adequate power and should have an independent secretariat and adequate fund for its proper functioning.

Dr Kamal said that to ensure violence-free polls, there should be strict laws against violation of election rules. It is a candidate is found involved in violence, he should be declared disqualified, the GF leader said.

All election cases must be resolved within a year, he said.

"All citizens over 18 years of age should be enlisted as voters' list should be framed according to ward, union, thana, district, and division," Dr Kamal said.

Held at the Purana Paltan Crossing with Dr Kamal in the chair, the rally was also addressed by, among others, GF presidium members Maj General (rtd) Khalilur Rahman, Matur Rahman, A M A Muhi, Ziaul Haq.

The forum leaders suggested increase of voting centres by a substantial number. This will attract voters for voting and influence of candidates over the centres will reduce, they said.

The government should implement the joint declaration of the three alliances, they said. The government controlled mass media should be given autonomy to promote their neutral role, the leaders said.

The GF leaders further said Parliament must formulate a law against unconstitutional removal of democratically elected government.

Regarding the Opposition boycott of Parliament session, the forum leaders stressed the need for immediate national dialogue and discussion in the Jatiya Sangsad.

Turning to the economy of the country, they said that the results of the government's reforms were not clear to the public. "Till now, investment rate is low, and dependence on foreign aid is not less than 70 per cent of the requirement," Dr Kamal said.

"The development process is being hindered by terrorist activities backed by different political parties," he said.

Dr Kamal said "bureaucracy is one of the main hindrances to investment and development".
