## US embassy to be closed May 29

The American Embassy and Consular Section, the US Information Service (USIS), and the American Cultural Center (ACC) Library and Student Counseling Service will remain closed on May 29 in observance of Memorial Day, a national holiday of the United States, says a USIS press release.

Memorial Day is observed throughout the United States on the last Monday of May. The day was observed initially to honour the victims of the American Civil War. With the passage of time, Memorial Day has become an occasion for honouring those Americans who lost their lives in all wars.

Memorial Day is also observed in the United States with parades organised by veterans' organisations. The summer holiday season traditionally begins on the Memorial Day weekend. The most popular annual event of Memorial Day is the 500-mile race at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

## Steps taken to recast disaster management structure

State Minister for Disaster Management and Relief Harun Al-Rashid said the government has taken up various steps for remodelling its disaster management structure, including renaming the Relief Ministry in conformity with the UN declaration of International Decade for Natural Disaster Reduction (IDNDR), reports BSS.

Presenting a paper at the world conference on Natural Disaster Reduction, held at Yokohama, Japan on May 24, the state minister said due to the new measures of the government when a strong cyclone hit the Bangladesh coast on May 2, the loss of lives were limited to only 133.

This was made possible by early warning system, timely evacuation of about eight lakh people to the cyclone shelters and through effective motiva-

tion activities," he said. Referring to the special attention of the government for disaster management, the state minister said the National Disaster Management Council (NDMC) headed by Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, was formed to give adequate importance to this field.

Rashid observed that there exists a wide scope and urgent need for regional cooperation in reduction of disaster such as flood and drought.

Rashid, who is leading the Bangladesh delegation at the conference, Wednesday presided over the fourth meeting of the plenary session of the conference where a South African delegate was invited to take floor for the first time in 20 years in a UN conference.
