BOU VC for maximum use of TV for spreading education

Vice Chancellor of Bangladesh Open University (BOU) Prof M Shamsul Kabir said the BOU teachers' training programme, conducted through the teachers' training college, was gradually becoming popular throughout the country.

'With the development of media technology, the advanced world has ensured more utilisation of the media for spreading education. Considering the backwardness of our country, we, too, need to ensure maximum use of our media for the rapid spread of education, especially for those who are not in a position to go through the institutional academic process', he said.

Prof Shamsul Kabir said this at the concluding ceremony of the first batch BOU B.Ed course at the teachers' training college auditorium in the city.

He said one of the main objectives of BOU was to promote girls' education in the country with a view to ensuring their role as the partners of national development.

'BOU has a bias for the girls, specially for those who live in the remote areas of the country so that they could develop their competence and self reliance side by side establishing their social status, he said.

Prof Ali said the BOU was also trying to enroll the students of all ages and levels, who did not get the chance to avail institutional education, in its course to turn them into a skilled manpower.

13th ACMR to be held in Dhaka

The 13th Asian Conference for Mentally Retarded (ACMR) will be held here in 1997, reports BSS.

The Society for Care and Education of Mentally Retarded, Bangladesh (SCEMRB) at a meeting of its national council yesterday with its President DP Barua in the chair, endorsed this decision in response to a proposal from the Asian Federation of Mentally Retarded (AFMR) in its Seoul conference last year.

A 71-member conference preparatory committee with Alamgir M.A Kabir as chairman, D.P Barua as co-chairman and J.P Mamun as secretary general has been elected by the national council for holding the first-ever international conference to be hosted by the SCEMRB.

The day-long meeting, attended by representatives from the branches all over the country passed several amendments to its constitution and also passed annual budget of 1994 and proposed budget of 1995.

Karl Johan Haanes, advisor to the SCEMRB from the Norwegian donor organisation NFFU, addressed the national council and exchanged views on expanding and broadening the SCEMRB for the welfare of persons with mental retardation.

The leaders are: President Mohamed Hosni Mubarak of Egypt, President Saddam Hussein of Iraq, President Sali Berisha of Albania, President Mustapha Mizouni of Tunisia, President Mahamane Ousmane of Niger, President Abdou Diouf of Senegal and Jacques Diouf, Director General of the FAO.

The world leader have felicitated President Abdur Rahman Biswas on the occasion of holy Eid-ul-Azha, reports UNB. In separate messages, they wished him good health and happiness and peace and prosperity of the people of Bangladesh and the Muslim Ummah.
