A Beacon of Hope

Lal Babu was a leprosy patient who once lived in a cemetery. Today he pulls a rickshaw and believes his leprosy is curable. Poppy has no parents and did not know what a warm hug was. Now she is in the 8th grade and plans to be a doctor. Birendra Nath Das was a cleaner in homes. At present he is in the 11th grade and has excelled in his SSC examination with four letter marks. These are just a few cases where individuals have to be thankful to the Salvation Army operating in Bangladesh.

The Salvation Army which began in England in 1865, commenced working in India in 1880s. It started working in Bangladesh in Sayedpur and Nilfamari around the turn of the century. It commenced work again after the partition of India on of in the 70's with cyclone and flood relief. Since the Liberation War it began relief work in a big way with its headquarters in Dhaka. After ten years it gradually took up development work.

The S.A. Girls' Home, started in '77, caters to the need of orphan girls and daughters of widows who have no means of support. This home is supported by funds generated by the S.A. and through foreign sponsorship. It

The MCH clinic treats a total of 200 patients évery day. Common illness treated here are related to poor sanitation, poor housing and insufficient water supply for the area, and are mainly skin and chest diseass. Meanwhile the TB clinic has treated 2248 patients while the leprosy clinic has treated 1259 patients.

The SA has been running an extensive education programme in Jessore for almost 20 years. Perhaps the largest part of this programme is its educational work which is offering education to nearly 1000 children each year from '72 in Jessore and Khulna.

The SA Ghurulia Community Development Project is meeting the needs of children and families in six rural villages - Ghurulia. Kanejpur, Kholadanga, Sitarampur and Ramnagar. The total population of the villages are 20,000 people and the project covers 20 per cent of the population. It deals with matters such as adult literacy, distribution of rickshaws and the installations of tubewell and

teaches housekeeping, traditional cooking, gardening, poultry, sewing embroidery, jute craft work, music and typing.

The S.A. Blind Boy's Home, began in '83, teaches Braille upto grade 5. It also provides vocational training for at least two years in bamboo work, bookbinding, plastic weaving. gardening and music. It teaches the boys' mobility to enable them to move confidently. They are provided with sufficient tools to start on their own when they leave.

The S.A. Deaf Children's School started with the help of HICARE, has at present 33 students who are being trained to learn to speak. Here the children are provided hearing aids and ancillary equipment to enable the deaf and profoundly deaf to better utilize what hearing they have. The students are provided day school oral coaching to bring them up to the standard of hearing and speaking so that they can be integrated into normal school.

The S.A. Medical Clinic, located in Mirpur suburb of Dhaka near the Bihari Camps, following the '71, War began with a mobile bus which operated from '75. A Leprosy clinic was operated from the driver's seat of the bus! By 1990 a clinic that offers a Maternal and Child Health Centre Care, Tuberculosis and Leprosy Control for a population of 113,000 was established. The projects provide control for leprosy and tuberculosis in the Mirpur area. and supplies income-generation assistance for leprosy and TB sufferers.

Dumuria Health Community project covers five villages. They have adult literacy programmes. and deal with such matters as nutrition. treatment of TB patients and schools for deaf children as well as for normal ones.

The SA Health Project at Jessore began in 1980 under USAID funding, has an operation clinic. This reaches 15 villages and deals with a population of 32,600. Among other things the project tries to reduce infant mortality: increases vaccination coverage, cases of follow-up and vaccination of TB patients: promotes contraceptive prevalence among married women of 15-45 years; prevents vitamin A deficiency, and develops an integrated programme for control of leprosy.

The Salvation Army in Bangladesh spends Tk 1.2 crore every year. There might be a specific donor like the World Vison funding for education programmes and for homes (for the blind and for the girls). In health services it receives help from TEAR fund in UK, the Leprosy Mission (UK), the Salvation Army in Australia, the Australian government and the Netherlands.It also receives funds from international headquarters in London and from countries like USA, Canada, New Zealand and

The Salvation Army, with its various projects and its inspired workers, is certainly a beacon of hope in the lives of many deprived and neglected in Bangladesh.

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday said accurate diagnosis is essential for proper treatment and for overall improvement of public

health, reports UNB. "There is no alternative to pathology for accurate diagnosis," Biswas told the 12th conference of pathologists at the auditorium of the National Museum yesterday morning.

The conference organised by Bangladesh Society of Pathologists (BSP) was addressed by Minister of Health and Family Welfare Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf, State Minister Mohammad Sirajul Haq Prof Badrur Rahman Khan and Dr AUM Mohsin. BSP President Prof SA Khaleg presided.

President Biswa's called upon the pathologists to extend their services in developing the public health by improving their skill.

Referring to the demand of setting a National Institute for Pathology, he said, "the government will stand beside you in setting up the institute but the initiative should come first from the private level."

He said initiative from the private level was essential to overcome the insufficiency of the health care facilities and develop proper health care system within a very short

He said the pathologists can expand their area of service by establishing modern laboratories equipped with latest technologies and applying their experiences.
