



Deputy Leader in Parliament Prof A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury yesterday called upon all individuals, groups and organisations to come forward to help build a self-reliant Bangladesh, reports UNB.

Malpractice at BTV alleged

A group of TV artistes yesterday alleged that malpractice by some producers had forced them to stay out of the screen.

The performers made the allegations at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club. It was arranged by Qazi Khurshid uz-Zaman Utpal, a drama artiste.

Utpal accused a producer of dropping him from a recent TV series.

"I signed a contract to play a role in the drama series ... I got the script and even performed in the first part of the serial ... but the producer phoned me saying that the playwright had decided to change the script and drop the character which I was supposed to portray," Utpal alleged.

Utpal also alleged that earlier this particular producer had demanded Tk 5000 from him for each series, which he refused to pay.

Among others, Ziaul Huda, Babul Ahmed, Mohon Khan, Kazi Asad, Anisur Rahman, Aminul Huq, Obayedul Huq Sarker, Khalilur Rahman Khan and Saifuddin expressed their grievances against some other producers without mentioning names.

They demanded removal of the producer concerned and threatened to go to a token hunger strike.

They said that because of the malpractice of some producers, enlisted TV performers were not getting programmes.

Installation:

Dealers will be responsible for installation of server, all workstations and peripherals, cables and configuration of Novell Netware software. All PC workstations must be able to download DOS and Windows applications and data before the installation is considered complete.

In addition, the supplier will be expected to link the RISC-based workstation with the Novell server and establish reliable communications. Finally, the supplier will be required to establish Novell links with an Apple Local-Talk network. The Novell network, the RISC-based workstation, and the Apple must all be able to communicate and transfer data transparently before the installation is considered complete.

Plugs on computer equipment must fit into receptacles of all power protection equipment, and BTC's wall sockets.

All equipment must be 220V or 220V convertible.

Compatibility: All software listed under Microcomputer Local Area Network Software (see- 27-47) must be compatible with the operating system and networking software for the network. Each software listed above under RISC Workstation software (items 48-54) must be UNIX compatible versions of that software and conform to X-Open standards.

Similarly, all peripherals must be compatible with the quoted computer system. In particular, the printer and plotter must be compatible with the hardware and software. The UPS and stabilizer must be capable of supporting the power requirements of the workstation. The workstation must be able to support a plotter, Postscript printer and high-speed printer (Epson DFX-5000) simultaneously, without requiring manual control. Any reliable automatic method is acceptable, whether by installing three parallel ports, using an automatic switching device, or some other approach.

Training: Suppliers are expected to provide training so that computer staff can use the operating system, plus install and operate application software on the hardware. This is especially true for the RISC system.

Warranty: All hardware — computers, monitors, keyboards, and mice, plus printers, print server adapters, hub, cables, power protection equipment and other peripherals — must carry a three-year warranty (or combination of warranty and service contract with spares for three years) for service and parts from the date of the commission of the computer systems.

Delivery: Bids in response to tenders must include statement listing the expected time the computers will arrive in Bangladesh, clear customs, and be delivered to BTC.
