

Seminar on cardiovascular held

Deputy Leader of the House Prof A M Badruddoza Chowdhury has said preventive measures are more important than curative ones to bring down the number of heart patients in the country, reports UNB.

If people are aware of preventive measures the cardiac problems will be reduced to a great extent, he told a seminar on "Problem and Prospect of Cardiovascular Services in Bangladesh" in the city yesterday.

Emphasising on the role of doctors in disseminating information about diseases, Prof Chowdhury said, "people have the right to know and it is the duty of the doctors to make the people aware of diseases."

"It is a shame for us to go abroad for treatment," he said and called for concerted efforts to make modern medical facilities available to the people. Government is ready to develop the health sector, he added.

Health Secretary Shamim Ahsan quoted a doctor of Birala Institute of Calcutta as saying that about 86 per cent of its patients are from Bangladesh.

The seminar, organised by Bangladesh Cardiac Society at Sonargaon Hotel, was chaired by its president Prof (Brig) A Mallick. Dr R K Khandker, Prof M H Sirajul Haq and Prof Nurunnabi addressed the seminar.

Bangla Academy urged to publish works of Prof Ashab Uddin

The Pragati Lekhak Shilpi Sangsad at a meeting in the city yesterday with Prof Nurunnabi in the chair urged the Bangla Academy to publish all literary works of late Prof Ashab Uddin Ahmad, reports BSS.

The sangsad members also expressed their deep condolence at the death of Prof Ahmad and conveyed their sympathy to the members of the bereaved family.

The meeting in its resolutions strongly condemned the attack on the Dainik Janakantha office by certain elements yesterday and demanded punishment to those responsible for such a heinous act.

The sangsad members in their resolutions also urged the government to lower the price of all publication materials, including the press of newsprint in the coming budget. They also urged the government to make a satisfactory solution of the present teachers' strike.

BAU convocation tomorrow

The third convocation of the Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) will be held in Mymensingh tomorrow, reports BSS.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia is expected to confer degrees on 700 out of 1515 agricultural graduates (1987-88 and 88-89) at the convocation, which is being held after a gap of two decades.

Since its establishment in 1961-62, the university produced 10119 graduates, 2,880 post-graduates and 25 PhDs. At present over five thousand students are studying under six faculties. First convocation of the university was held in 1968 when the Chancellor, the then Provincial Governor Abdul Monem Khan conferred degrees on the agricultural graduates.

After the independence, the second convocation took place in 1972 during which the Chancellor President Justice Abu Sayeed Chowdhury distributed the certificates among the graduates.

During Nurul Amin government the East Pakistan Veterinary College was established on the western bank of old Brahmaputra river. It was made the Agriculture University in the 1961-62 academic year covering an area of 1200 acres of land.

Nazrul confce begins

A three-day 'Nazrul Conference-1401' began in the city yesterday in observance of the 95th birth anniversary of National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam and the 30th founding anniversary of the Nazrul Academy, reports UNB.

State Minister for Cultural Affairs Prof Jahan Ara Begum inaugurated the conference with the President of the Nazrul Academy, Lutfar Rahman Sarkar in the chair.

Prof Jahan Ara said the government has been implementing various programmes for the preservation of Nazrul's works.

The state minister assured that government would take every possible steps to preserve the works of journalist and litterateur Nasiruddin and musician Abdul Ahad.

Nasiruddin's reburial beside Nazrul's mazar demanded

Speakers at a condolence meeting yesterday demanded that centenarian journalist Mohammad Nasiruddin be reburied beside the grave of National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam on the Dhaka University campus.

Journalist Nasiruddin, who died on May 22 last, was buried at the Shahid Muktijoddha graveyard at Mirpur in the city.

"To be buried beside the grave of Kazi Nazrul Islam was his last wish," Nurjahan Begum, his only daughter, informed the meeting.

The meeting held at the Saogat Press office under the aegis of the Mahila Samaj was presided over by poet Begum Sufia Kamal and addressed by Ayesha Khanom, general secretary of the Mahila Parishad, Sitara Musa, president of the Mahila Sangbadik Samity, Rabeya Majid, Dr Maliha Khatun, Dr Begum Jahan Ara, Arundhati Das Mukta, Rezia Rahman and Dr Monjushree Chowdhury.

Paying rich tribute to late Nasiruddin, Begum Sufia Kamal said Nasiruddin was like her father. He picked up Kazi Nazrul Islam and allowed to stay at his Saogat office, she said.

Nurjahan Begum, Nasiruddin's only daughter and the editor of Weekly Begum, said as he died on the day before the Eid day, they could not contact timely with the government officials concerned to bury him beside Kazi Nazrul Islam's mazar — although it was his last wish. They had to bury him at Shahid Muktijoddha graveyard at Mirpur.

She said Nasiruddin was the pioneer of renaissance of Muslim women of Indian sub-continent. He established Begum Club and published Weekly Begum in 1954, when there was no Muslim woman writer or journalist except Begum Rokya.

Death anniversary

The first death anniversary of noted journalist Shree Ranjan Kishor Das will be observed today, says a press release.

He died on this day of cardiac arrest.

He stated his journalistic career with daily Purbadesh.

He was working as joint editor in the daily Al Amin before his death.

The daily Al Amin will hold a discussion meet at its office today to observe Kishor's death anniversary.
