Trade bodies' reaction on budget

More trade and professional associations yesterday hailed the proposed budget for giving priority to the development of human resources, education and health.

However, they observed that the export sector was not given due emphasis in the budget.

The Exporters' Association of Bangladesh (EAB) and the Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters' Association (BGMEA) in separate statements called for withdrawal of deduction of 0.5 per cent tax at source.

Both organisation said the government should withdraw income tax and all types of VAT from all export-oriented industries.

They also suggested waiving VAT on insurance premium, telephone, electricity and C and F bills.

'Budget provision for harmonisation of tariff will reduce smuggling. All these will result in creating more and more domestic resources for the Annual Development Programme (ADP) thus leading the country towards a self-reliant economy,' said the exporters' association. The BGMEA while welcoming the budget, regretted that 'the garments export sector had been ignored in the budget speech.' The BGMEA termed as a milestone the 38 per cent allocation in the ADP for the domestic resources.

The Bangladesh Re-rolling Mills Association (BRMA) criticised the budget for increasing import duty on steel billets to 30 per cent from 15 per cent.

This will further increase the cost of quality steel materials and will affect all related sectors,' the association said.

It added that the increase was proposed despite the fact that the Tariff Commission had twice recommended reduction of import duty on billets from 15 per cent to 7.5.

The BRMA said the decrease of import duty on steel rods from 45 to 30 per cent would hit the billet-based steel rolling mills.

The association demanded withdrawal of the proposed increase of duty on imported billets. It suggested restoration of the previous rate of duty on both the items.

Tax Lawyers' Association

The Bangladesh Tax Lawyers' Association in a statement Saturday criticised the proposed national budget saying it does not contain steps for poverty alleviation and creation of jobs for the people.

Mizan concerned over future of democracy

Acting Chairman of Jatiya Party Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury yesterday expressed pessimism about the fate of parliamentary democracy because of the government's attitude towards parliament and the opposition, reports UNB.

'I am scared of the fate of parliamentary democracy in our country,' Chowdhury said pointing to the current deadlock in parliament and the placing of budget by the government in the House in absence of the opposition.

A veteran parliamentarian and former Prime Minister, Chowdhury termed as unprecedented the placing of national budget in the half-empty House, boycotted by the entire opposition.

'It's a violation of all precedences... In parliamentary democracy, government means both the ruling party and the opposition,' he said.

He said the present impasse in Parliament could only be solved through placing a neutral caretaker government bill by the ruling party before Parliament.

The Opposition is boycotting Parliament for constitutional provision of a neutral interim government for supervising next general elections.

Asked about the modality of their caretaker government, the JP leader said the boycotting opposition groups had reached consensus on the framework of the proposed caretaker government. 'We will not spell out it until the
