# Dhaka Day by Day Wretched Slum Life

For Rahela and many others, barefooted and apparently unclad children in urban slums, stinking puddles and garbage heaps provide fun in these days of their childhood. Since play grounds are even regarded as a luxury in planned residential areas of Dhaka, the metropolis with the highest population growth

in Asia, the children of TT Para slum are doubly disadven-

taged. Every year poverty and environmental disaster draw thousands along the roads and railway tracts. The swarming city confines them to the railway lines. So, the name of the slum was after TTE, a railway post.

Here in this slum, the rugged earth road snaking through closelyspaced rows of huts built with mud and polythene is interrupted by muddy pools of foul smelling water, flowing from open drains. A member of the

civil society, going along the narrow foot paths, has to use a handkerchief to resist vomiting. But for 45-year-old Razia Khatun, a maid servant for nearby houses and living here, this is a daily reality, as it is for so many like her.

"This is how we live, and life continues,". says the single mother of four. "Our efforts to get assistance from the city corporation have been frustrated and neglected," she adds.

Although TT Para Basti, located almost at the heart of the city, has an estimated 500 households, the slum has a thatched and tinroofed primary school run by a German NGO. The children, aged between four and eleven, who play in the muddy puddles, ought to be in

school. But they are not.

> > other way, but to leave contaminated water to flow in or out any how. "People who fre-

quent me constantly complain of dysentery and food poisoning," he says. The urban sanita-

tion situation in Dhaka's squatter settlement is complicated by laws, as the inhabitants are not eligible for becoming voter in the city corporation elections. While the illegal nature of the slums, settlements upon the illegally occupied government lands, denies the population there

the basic official services. "In my opinion, firstly policies need to be revised so as to better meet their basic service keeping pace with the existing reality," says Dr

"In my opinion, brave steps like the social mobilisation in the real context and making a way for the access to the resources - side-stepping archaic by-laws that stifle innovation - have the potential to improve degraded slum environments," concludes Dr Mamunur Rahman.
