Continued from page 6 pines on 12 June, 1898. This remains the most important date in modern Philippine history. Independence had been won. If it was lost, it only needed to be restored.

The Filipinos thereafter established Asia's first democratic constitutional Republic. Aguinaldo was its President. Neither the Republic nor independence, however, would last long. By February 1899, the Filipinos were engaged in a new war against the American forces that had arrived from mainland USA. Faced with superior arms and firepower, the

Philippine army led by General Antonio Luna, who had obtained military education in Germany, was forced to retreat. President Aguinaldo was soon captured and the Republic fell to America by 1901. In the next 40-some years, however, with outstanding US governors like William Howard Taft administering the country, the once bitter enemies

were to become close friends. The Philippine independence movement shifted into peaceful gear as American colonial rule gradually allowed political parties to form under a system where Filipions enjoyed the same basic freedoms as Americans in mainland USA.
