AL MP's donation for dead teacher's family

Awami League leader Alhaj Syed Abul Hossain, MP, in a statement yesterday condoled the death of Shahjada Sikder, a teacher of the Patuakhali Boalia High School, who died of heart attack in the city Monday. He was participating in the non-government teachers' sit-in.

Syed Abul Hossain also handed over a cheque of Tk 50,000 as his personal donation to Kamruzzaman, Convener of the Central Teachers' Action Liaison Committee, for the family members of the late teacher.

The AL MP, who is also the acting secretary of Commerce and Industry of the party, prayed for the salvation of Shahjada's departed soul and expressed his heartfelt sympathy for the members of his bereaved family.

Earlier, the AL leader addressed the striking teachers in front of the Jatiya Press Club and urged the government to accept their demands.

He also distributed some food items and fruits among the teachers.

Contraband seized

RAJSHAHI, June 14: The Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) seized Indian contraband goods worth about Taka Three lakh from several places of the district on Monday, official sources said here today, reports UNB.

The contraband included cattle head, nylon net, surma, imitation ornaments, cosmetics and injection.

The BDR men of the 20 rifle battalion seized these goods during conducting several separate anti-smuggling drives on Monday and later on, deposited the items to Rajshahi customs.

Rafiq urges Opposition to join Parliament

BNP standing committee member and Housing and Public Works Minister Rafiqul Islam Miah yesterday urged the Opposition members to participate in the proceedings of Parliament and make positive contribution for achieving free and fair elections, reports BSS.

Addressing a public meeting organised by the Sutrapur thana unit of the BNP at Kaptan Bazar in the city to mark the 13th death anniversary celebrations of president Ziaur Rahman, Rafiq said different countries of the world had achieved free and fair elections by improving election procedures and providing independence to the Election Commission and not by nominating a caretaker government.

Food Minister and city BNP president Mir Shawkat Ali also spoke on the occasion. Presided over by local ward commissioner Kazi Abul Basher, the meeting was also addressed by the leaders of Kaptan Bazar unit of the BNP and its front organisations.

Rafiq said that the BNP was not afraid of a caretaker government. "But in principle, we are against a nominated caretaker government which is contrary to democracy particularly to the healthy growth of parliamentary democracy," he added.

Referring to the provisions of Rules of Procedures of Parliament, Rafiq said the Opposition could bring any bill, even money bill, to the House. But instead of doing so, the Opposition is asking the Treasury bench to bring a bill regarding the formation of a caretaker government, which is contrary to democratic concept, structure and fundamental principles.

He pointed out that if the government brought such a bill under pressure from the opposition, it (the government) would naturally lose its right to speak against the bill, which meant the government would have nothing to speak against the bill.

Rafiq said such kind of pressure by the minority members on the majority was tantamount to the denial of rights of the majority members. Referring to the imposition of a condition by Leader of the Opposition Sheikh Hasina that the bill had to be brought by the government for holding a debate on it, Rafiq said that such a condition would deprive the government of recording its views and arguments independently.

Rafiq said that the purpose of the opposition was not clear whether they really wanted free and fair elections or wanted to remove the elected government.

He said if the purpose is to hold impartial elections, they should come to Parliament and discuss ways and means to achieve such a goal.

Dutch team meets Majid

A visiting delegation of the Netherlands called on Agriculture and Irrigation Minister M Majid-ul Haq at Bangladesh Secretariat yesterday and discussed progress of the component 20 of the Flood Action Plan (FAP) reports UNB.

The delegation was led by Fred Roos, Director, Development Cooperation of Asia Department of the Netherlands.

Earlier, the delegation visited the proposed site of FAP-20 and also exchanged views with the high officials of the Irrigation Ministry.

The delegation informed the minister about the overall progress of FAP studies and also expressed their satisfaction over it.

Blood donation at NSU

The Social Services Club of the North South University organised a blood donation programme in collaboration with Shandhani at the university campus in the city Monday, says a press release.

Eighty-one students and six members of the faculty donated blood.
