

Italy's fate in balance

Mexico, Ireland thru' to second round

WASHINGTON, June 28: Mexico and Ireland went through to the second round of the World Cup today after drawing their last matches in the most tightly-contested group at the finals, reports

The Mexicans drew 1-1 with Italy to finish top of Group E by virtue of scoring more goals than any of their rivals after the four teams each finished level on four points.

Ireland, who drew 0-0 with Norway in East Rutherford. were second in the group and qualified for the last 16 ahead of third-placed Italy because they won their match against the Italians 1-0.

Both Ireland and Italy had scored two goals. In which


