

### 22 more branches of Shishu Academy to be set up

Forty-two branches of Bangladesh Shishu Academy have been set up with a view to flourishing latent of the children, reports UNB.

State Minister for Women and Children Affairs Begum Sarwari Rahman disclosed this while inaugurating the Manikganj District Branch of Bangladesh Shishu Academy yesterday.

The function was addressed, among others, by Nizamuddin Khan MP, Director of Shishu Academy Golam Kibria and its governing board member Sirajul Islam Selim.

Later, the State Minister visited the Manikganj district unit of Jatiya Mohila Sangstha and distributed saplings among the poor women.

### JS body discusses allocation of Baridhara plots

The Petition Committee of Jatiya Sangsad in a meeting with Speaker Shaikh Razzak Ali in the chair discussed allegations of irregularities in allocation of 'J Block' plots at Baridhara in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

The allottees of those plots in the posh residential area petitioned the parliamentary committee that RAJUK was not handing over their plots long after allocation and payment of their price.

RAJUK pleaded that delay in development and handover of the plots was due to complexities in acquisition of land.

The committee instructed concerned authorities to resolve the problems rapidly.

On the basis of another petition, the committee also discussed elaborately administrative control, building and transfer from the Works Ministry to the Sangsad Secretariat of 233 quarters of government officers at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar.

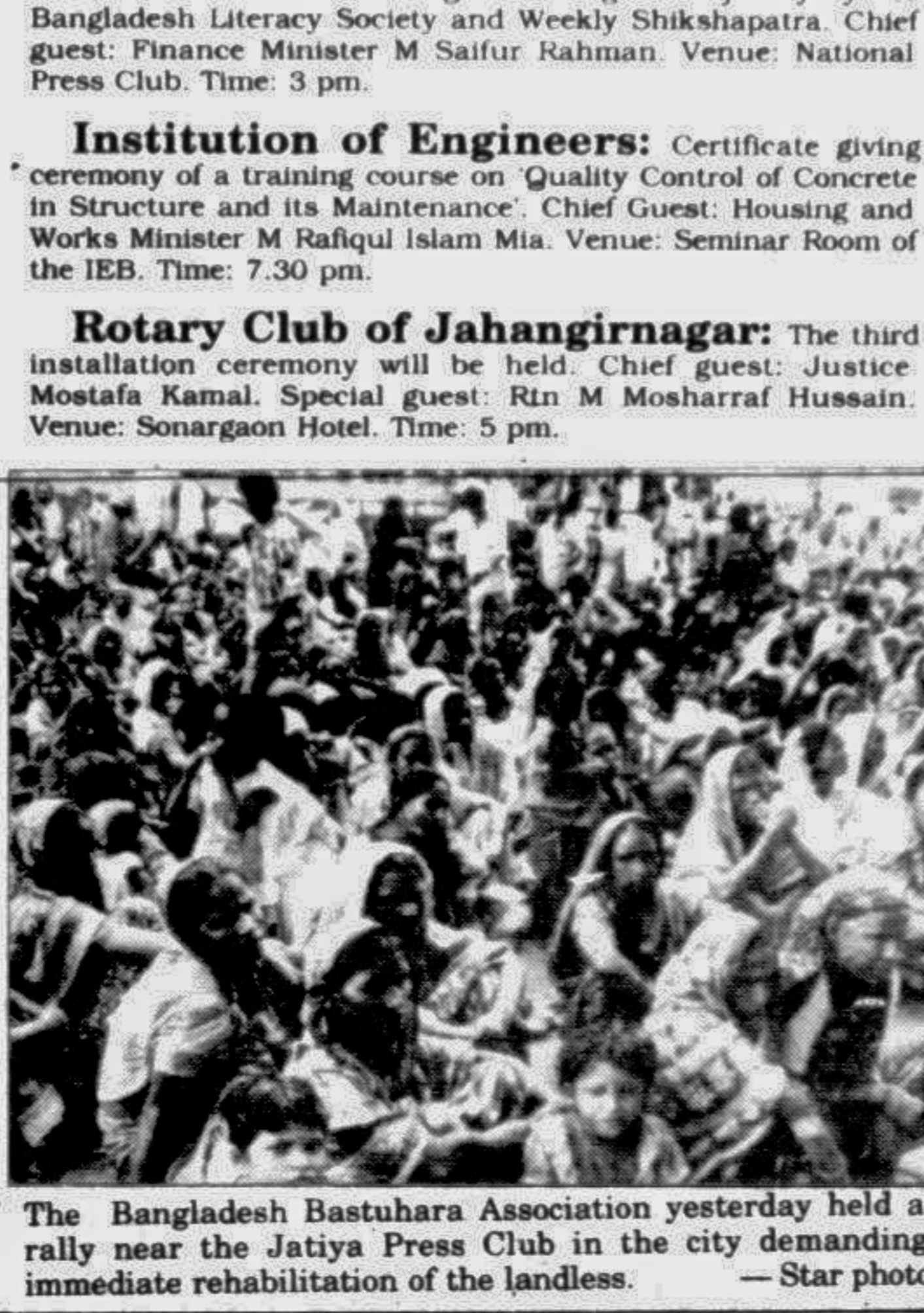
