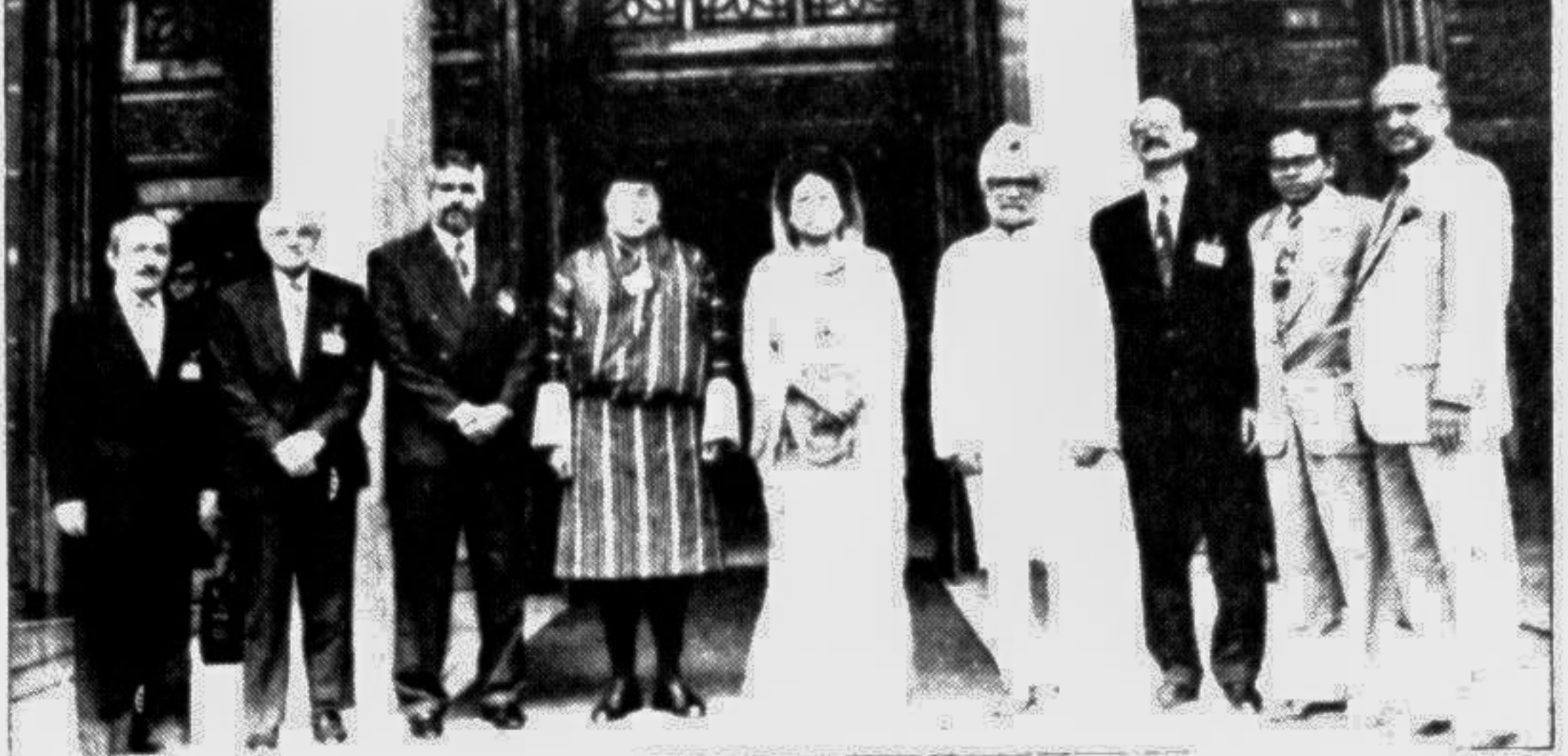

SAARC ministers visit Grameen Bank, BRAC

The finance and planning ministers of the SAARC countries, now meeting in Dhaka, yesterday visited some projects to have first-hand knowledge about Bangladesh's efforts to alleviate poverty, reports UNB.
The visiting ministers, attending the two-day ministerial level meeting which opened yesterday morning, split into three groups and visited Grameen Bank, BRAC and the Palli Karma Shahayak Foundation in the afternoon.
Indian Finance Minister Dr Manmohan Singh, Maldives Deputy Minister for Planning, Human Resources and Environment Dr Abdul Sattar Yoosuf and Sri Lankan Finance Secretary N V K K Weragoda visited the head office of the Grameen Bank, acclaimed internationally for its poverty alleviation programmes.
Nepalese State Minister for Commerce and Civil Supplies Surendra Prasad Chaudhury, visited the Palli Karma Sahayak Foundation, a government-funded organisation aimed at alleviating poverty through different self-employment activities.
Finance and Economic Affairs Adviser to Pakistan Prime Minister, V A Jafarey and Bhutan Planning Minister Lyonpo C Dorji visited a BRAC project at Rajendrapur in Gazipur.
Grameen Bank Managing Director Prof Mohammad Yunus welcomed the ministers and government officials who visited the bank's head office and briefed them about its activities.
He informed the visitors that the Grameen Bank, owned 92 per cent by its borrowers, is lending Tk 125 crore each month to the rural people in small loans. The recovery rate of the bank is 98 per cent.
Prof Yunus, a renowned economist, said the programmes like the Food-for-Work will not help eradicate poverty as they are merely 'poor-alive programmes'. He suggested that the poor be provided with income-generating programmes ensuring their access to credit.
Dr Manmohan Singh, considered a champion of economic reforms in India, appreciated the activities of the bank and had shown keen interest in its activities.
Grameen Bank officials Khaled Shams, Mozammel Haq and Prof Latif, and Indian High Commissioner in Dhaka K Raghunath were present during the briefing.
Palli Karma Sahayak Foundation chairman Nazrul Islam apprised the Nepalese Minister about the activities of the foundation at Dhanmondi.
Islam said the foundation, with a recovery rate of 99 per cent, so far disbursed loans of Tk 33 crore among 1,81,845 landless.
It provides loans in areas like small trade, paddy husking, small cattle and goat farms, and cane and wood works.

DUTA for naming of hall after Jahanara Imam

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) has proposed that a residential hall of the Dhaka University be named after Jahanara Imam to perpetuate her memory.
The DUTA in a condolence meeting yesterday also demanded trial of all 'war criminals' including Golam Azam in a special tribunal, and hoped that the agitation against the 'killers' and 'collaborators' of 1971 would go ahead.
Besides, the teachers have decided to establish a 'Jahanara Imam Memorial Trust Fund' to arrange special lecture series on Independence and Liberation War every year.
