Call to publish works of Nasiruddin

Speakers at a condolence meeting yesterday stressed on the need for highlighting the contribution of Saogat Editor Mohammad Nasiruddin in improving the conservative Bengali Muslim society during the British period.

The condolence meeting was organised by some 27 socio-cultural organisations including Women for Women, Udichi Shilpi Gosthi, ADAB, Chhayanaut, Nazrul Academy, and Bangla Academy at the National Museum auditorium.

They called upon the authorities to publish Nasiruddin's works.

Presided over by poet Sufia Kamal, it was addressed by Prof Anisuzzaman, Harun-ur-Rashid of Bangla Academy, Begum Husne Alam, Asaduzzaman Nur, Nasiruddin's wife Fatema Begum, Obaidul Haq and others.

The speakers said that Nasiruddin overcame the prejudices of Bengali Muslims by publishing the illustrated monthly Saogat in 1918. The Muslims were against publishing photographs till then, they pointed out.

The Saogat also introduced the Muslim writers and poets to the readers and national poet Kazi Nazrul Islam was one of them, the speakers said.

Besides, Md Nasiruddin initiated Weekly Begum from 1947 which was milestone for the development of women in this country.

The centenary journalist, born in November 20, 1888 in Chandpur, had formed innumerable socio-cultural organisations for the progress of the society.

The speakers urged the government to name a city road and a university hall after the journalist who died on May 21 last.
