The telephone in Bangladesh has been used by many Romeos and Juliets as the primary medium to exchange sweet or bitter nothings to each other. Sometimes these exchanges amount to marathon sessions going from two to six hours at a stretch! Since half of one's life may be spent on the phone, some people have taken it a step further and have decided to use this indispensable creation of Bell as a means to tie the knot!

Marriages conducted over the telephone is another example of what a slave man is of his own technology.

Telephonic matrimonials may sound a little strange to some, but it is possibly the most practical and easy way to get married. This, however, proved a little embarrassing when, at the request of both parents-in-law, the groom was asked to speak to the bride, on the phone of course. The poor couple had little option but to exchange pleasantries like 'How are you?' and "how's the weather." Later both sides had a miniature feast, the Dhaka party completing the event with kachchi biryani, borhani and

immigration, financial constraints and so on may be the reason why the two cannot promise 'until death do us part' to face.

The advantages of this unusual method of plunging into uncertainty and life-long imprisonment are many. The couple in question does not have to go through the endless tension associated with weddings - waiting for the groom's arrival, the bride's coming out on time from the beauty parlour with the necessary paint, beeline hairdo and other paraphernalia. The availability of the Kazi (since most of these marriages are amongst Muslims). The decorators going on strike, the list is endless. Although there is usually a small congregation of relatives and friends on both sides of the ocean, the festivities are nowhere near as elaborate and more importantly, as expensive, as regular weddings. Moreover, since we still do not have telephones with visual aides, there is really no reason to get all dressed up for the wedding. Imagine getting married in one of your dowdy reject night gowns!

Well of course this may be a little unrealistic As far as Bangladeshi marriages go, the event is more for the relatives and friends of the two people rather than for themselves. Take the young lady in Dhaka who got married to her husband in the US over the telephone. While the bride sat in full wedding regalia in her Maghbazar home flanked by all her relatives who were also in costume, the groom had to wear his sherwani, pagri and nagra. The 'Kazi'

young woman in Dhaka whose husband to be was stuck in Beijing, China. The two of them had gone to university together, fallen in love and managed to get scholarships to China. The only hitch to this happy love story was that the young man in question had gone to China first and the only way that the woman's parents would let her join him was if they got married. Thus the two joined their lives over the telephone and it was almost a year before they met for the first time as man and wife.

All this may sound very romantic but there are disadvantages of telephonic matrimonials. Not being able to be together after the marriage is perhaps the most difficult part for the newly weds.' Often, as in the case of arranged marriages, the two people have not-even seen each other except in photographs which makes this process quite scary. Apart from the cruel separation, are other minor irritations such as the confusion created by cross connections with mischievous eavesdroppers who can make havoc on the line and bad connections that can make 'Kabul' sound like 'Ujbuk'

Inspite of all this, however, many people appreciate the convenience of tying the knot with so little fuss and time. Then there is always the possibility of getting cold feet at the last moment, in which case all one has to do is cut the line with a chick, something virtually impossible, face to face.



## 'Accountability of doctors needed to ensure proper healthcare'

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf yesterday stressed the need for developing the accountability of the doctors and nurses to ensure proper healthcare facilities to the people, reports BSS.

Inaugurating a three-day workshop on 'National Plan of Action for Nursing Development in Bangladesh', he said construction of hospitals. buying equipment and providing medicines alone cannot ensure health facilities to all unless accountability of the health personalities is there.

Organised by the Directorate of Nursing Services in collaboration with World Health Organisation (WHO), representatives from different organisations and institutions from home and abroad are taking part in the workshop to recommend measures for the promotion of nursing service in the country.

Deputy Minister for Health and Family Welfare Mohammad Serajul Haque, Director General of Health Services Prof Mohammad Nurun Nabi, Chief of Health and Population of World Bank Dr Philip Gower, Advisor for Nursing of WHO regional office in New Delhi Dr

Sally Bisch. Acting WHO Representative in Bangladesh Dr Rusdi Aliuddin, WHO Nursing Adviser in Bangladesh Dr Farinaz Parsay, Director of Nursfng Services Dilruba Begum and Assistant Director Begum Jahanara spoke on the occasion. Additional Secretary of Health and Family Welfare Mohammad Fazlur Rahman chaired the function.

Yusuf said the goal of the present government was to 'economise' and develop the health services through ensuring the proper use of limited resources

He said at present there are only 11,000 registered nurses in the country as against 22,000 doctors while the required number of nurses is about 60,000. "No health care system can't run without skilled nurses and therefore the government will do all possible for the promotion of the nursing profession in the country," he said.

Yusuf hoped that the work shop would recommend necessary measures for the development of nursing service including its function, accountability, structural organisation and education and service


